**NCAC ANNOUNCES ALL-CONFERENCE BASKETBALL TEAM;**  
**WITTENBERG, WOOSTER EACH WITH TWO FIRST-TEAMERS**

CLEVELAND, OH -- Wittenberg University and The College of Wooster each had two first-team selections to lead the 1990 All-North Coast Athletic Conference men's basketball team. The balloting was done by the NCAC Basketball Coaches' Association.

Wittenberg's **Brad Baldrige (Dublin, OH/Dublin)**, a junior center, and **Bill Funderburg (Greenville, OH/Greenville)**, a senior guard, were joined on the first team by Wooster sophomores **Stan Aukamp (Charlotte, NC/Canton South (OH))**, a center, and **Erich Riebe (Wooster, OH/Waynedale)**, a guard. Case Western Reserve University sophomore guard **Ed Saxon (Cleveland, OH/St. Ignatius)** rounds out the first team. Riebe was a second-team selection last season, Aukamp did not make the team a year ago, and Baldrige, Funderburg and Saxon are all new to the Conference.

All nine teams were represented in the vote, with seven different schools having players named to either of the first two teams. The following is a complete list of the 1990 All-NCAC men's basketball team:
