

NCAC Cross Country Championships...add one

The Spartan squad rallied in their adversity and turned in a true championship performance. They were led by the NCAC first-place winner, senior Mark Roshon (New London, OH), who ran the race of his career, finishing with a time of :27.01 over the 8,000-meter (5 miles) course, the class of the 49-man field.

Roshon has been CWRU's third man all season but rallied in his final outing of the regular season. CWRU had the top three finishers. Ed Menis was second with a time of :27.13, while Gary Tressler was third. The Spartans landed four of the top nine runners, while Allegheny had four of the top eight.

The top seven runners in each of the men's and women's race were declared All-North Coast Athletic Conference. The All-Conference teams and their times are listed below.

The top three teams in the men's and women's races will advance to the NCAA Division III Regionals to be held November 16, along with the top fifteen placers in each race.
