

CWRU and Allegheny Repeat...add one

Denison, who finished in a close third place with 77 points, was paced by Dan Coffman who garnered the sixth-place position in :26.13. Allegheny held the fourth-place spot with 106 points; Oberlin was fifth with 133 points; Kenyon landed the sixth place with 139 points; and Ohio Wesleyan University ended the day in seventh place with 183 points. Coach Bill Sudeck of Case Reserve was recipient of the NCAC men's coach of the year honors.

The top seven runners in each of the men's and women's race were declared All-North Coast Athletic Conference. The All-Conference times and their times are listed below.

The top three teams in the men's and women's races will advance to the NCAA Division III Regionals to be held November 15, along with the top fifteen placers in each race.
