**OHIO WESLEYAN'S COUGHLIN AND SCHLEGEL SWEEP TOP HONORS**

**CLEVELAND** -- A pair of Ohio Wesleyan attackers have closed out their seasons on a high note. Bishops senior **Matt Coughlin (Denver, CO/Regis Jesuit)** has been named Player of the Year and freshman **John Schlegel** has been picked as the Newcomer of the Year to highlight the 2002 All-North Coast Athletic Conference men's lacrosse selections.

Coughlin had 33 goals and 34 assists to lead all scorers during the regular season (5.58 ppg), helping Ohio Wesleyan to a second-place finish and a 9-5 overall record. He is a three-time All-NCAC selection, also earning second-team honors last spring and honorable mention status in 2000. Schlegel is the league's top freshman after notching 32 goals and 15 assists in his rookie campaign. He is an All-NCAC second team honoree and is one of only five first-year players honored this season.

Six members of the 2002 first team earned the same honors last spring - four from Denison and two from Kenyon. Seniors **Ryan Berger (Devon, PA/Conestoga)**, **Jon Staunton (Charlottesville, VA/St. Ann Belfield)** and **Peter Royer (Avon, CT/Westminster)**, an attacker, a midfielder and a goalie, respectively, and junior midfielder **Kevin Sullivan (Timonium, MD/Boys' Latin)** represent the Big Red. Senior attacker **Justin Martinich (Bay Shore, NY/Bay Shore)** and senior defender **Blaire Modic (Sewickley, PA/Sewickley)** represent the Lords. Martinich, Berger and Royer have each earned All-NCAC nods for four consecutive years. Royer has made four straight first-team appearances, while Berger was also named to the first team in 2000. He was second-team pick in 1999. Martinich was named to the second team in 2000 and was an honorable mention pick in 1999.

Denison's **Mike Caravana** earned Coach of the Year honors for the third time after guiding the Big Red to a 12-2 record and their seventh North Coast championship. He has compiled a 120-51 record during his 12 seasons at the helm.
