**NCAC Men's Lacrosse Special**

**ALL-NCAC MEN'S LACROSSE SQUAD ANNOUNCED;  
SCHLEGEL REPEATS AS MVP**

**CLEVELAND** -- Ohio Wesleyan senior **John Schlegel (Chevy Chase, MD/Gonzaga)** has been named Player of the Year for the second straight season to highlight the 2005 All-North Coast Athletic Conference men's lacrosse selections.

Schlegel had 54 goals and 23 assists to lead the North Coast in goals (4.15 per game), assists (1.77) and points (5.92), helping Ohio Wesleyan earn its 15th NCAC championship. He is a four-time All-NCAC selection, twice earning first team and twice earning second-team honors.

Five members of the 2005 first team earned the same honors last spring - two from Ohio Wesleyan and one each from Denison, Kenyon and Wooster. Schlegel and classmate **Brian Small (Baltimore, MD/Calvert Hall)** represent the champion Bishops. Denison senior **Kurt Federer (Columbus, OH/Upper Arlington)** earned his fourth straight first-team recognition, while Kenyon senior **David Deal (Pittsburgh, PA/Shady Side Academy)** earned his third. Wooster junior **Shawn Handy (Carrboro, NC/Chapel Hill)** earns his third All-NCAC nod, and second selection to the first team. He was a second-team choice in 2003.

Wooster sophomore **Adam Chapman (Englewood, CO/Kent Dover)** and junior **Alex Morriss (Chevy Chase, MD/Bullis School)**, and Ohio Wesleyan senior **Douglas Freeman (Villanova, PA/Blair Academy, NJ)** all made the jump to the first team after earning second-team recognition in 2004. Morris was also a second-team choice in 2003, while Freeman earned honorable mention that year.

Ohio Wesleyan freshman **Chris Eccles (Secane, PA/Monsignor Bonner)** was named the league's Newcomer of the Year in balloting by the coaches after the midfielder scored 14 goals and recorded seven assists in his debut season.

Ohio Wesleyan's **Sean Ryan** earned Coach of the Year honors for the third time after guiding the Bishops their 15th North Coast championship. The Bishops travel to Gettysburg (14-3) on May 14 to start the NCAA Division III tournament. Ryan has posted a 60-25 (.706) record in six seasons at the helm of the OWU program, and has claimed five NCAC titles or co-championships in that span.
