**ALL-NCAC MEN'S SOCCER SQUAD ANNOUNCED;**

**November 20, 2003**

**MILLIGAN, MONTGOMERY & KRIGBAUM EARN INDIVIDUAL HONORS**

**CLEVELAND** --Wooster's **Adam Milligan (Orrville, OH/Orrville)** and Allegheny's **Ben Montgomery (McMurray, PA/Peter's Township)** have been named co-Offensive Players of the Year and Ohio Wesleyan's **Jeff Krigbaum (Canal Winchester, OH/Canal Winchester)** has been named Defensive Player of the Year to highlight the 2003 All-North Coast Athletic Conference men's soccer selections.

Milligan, a junior forward, finished second in the North Coast in scoring with 14 goals and 31 points for 1.72 points per game, leading the Scots to a share of the NCAC regular-season championship. Montgomery, a junior midfielder, was the catalyst for a team that scored 2.28 goals per game and allowed 0.83 goals a contest this season. Krigbaum earns his second straight first-team All-NCAC nod. He is the anchor of the Bishops' solid defensive unit.

Denison forward **Steve Cole (Dublin, OH/Coffman)** was selected as Newcomer of the Year. The sophomore hit the back of the net eight times and assisted on four other scores for the co-champion Big Red.

In addition to Krigbaum, other repeat first-team selections were Ohio Wesleyan senior midfielder **Paul Smith (Dublin, OH/Watterson)**, Wooster junior **Andrew DeBord (Cincinnati, OH/Indian Hill)** and Wooster sophomore forward **Brian Conaway (Twinsburg, OH/Chamberlin)**. Moving up to the First Team from honorable mention status in 2002 were Denison junior **Chad Huber (Fairfield, OH/Fairfield)**, Allegheny's Montgomery and Gator junior **Matt Moffa (Pittsburgh, PA/North Hills)**.

Wooster's **Graham Ford** is the North Coast's Coach of the Year for the first time. Ford is 83-62-17 (.565) in his nine seasons at the helm of the Scots' men's soccer program. Wooster claimed a share of the NCAC regular-season championship and the top seed in the NCAC tournament. The Scots reached the championship game of the conference tournament, before falling to champion Ohio Wesleyan, 2-1.
