**ALL-NCAC MEN'S SOCCER SQUAD ANNOUNCED;
CONAWAY AND MARTIN EARN INDIVIDUAL HONORS**

CLEVELAND --Wooster's **Brian Conaway (Twinsburg, OH/Chamberlin)** and Ohio Wesleyan's **Ryan Martin (Dublin, OH/Wellington)** have been named Players of the Year to highlight the 2005 All-North Coast Athletic Conference men's soccer selections.

Conaway, a senior forward, led the league in scoring with 12 goals and five assists for 29 points over 16 games (1.81 points per game), leading the Scots to a sixth-place finish during the regular season. In addition to leading the NCAC in overall and per game goals and points, he was also first with five game-winning goals and was tied for fifth in total assists and was fourth in assists per game (0.31 apg). He earns his fourth straight first-team nod and his third Player of the Year nod. He previously earned the award in 2002, as well as last fall. He was also named the North Coast Newcomer of the Year in 2002. Conaway finishes his career as the third 100-point scorer in Fighting Scot history with 104 points, including 43 goals.

Martin, a senior midfielder, was second on the Battling Bishops with 23 points off seven goals and nine assists (1.10 ppg) while splitting time at both ends of the field. His nine assists shared the league lead. Martin also ranked in the top 10 amongst all conference players in points (fourth), points per game (sixth) and in total goals (10th-tie). He is making his third consecutive first-team appearance. Martin helped lead the Battling Bishops to their 15th North Coast title and a perfect 10-0 conference record.

In addition to Conaway and Ryan, other repeat first-team selections were Ohio Wesleyan senior forward **Jeff Fisher (Westerville, OH/North)** and Oberlin senior back **Evan Childress (Free Union, VA/Western Albermarle)**. Fisher, who shared the NCAC assist lead with Martin, picked up his third straight first-team nod while Childress picked up his second. Denison senior **Steve Cole (Dublin, OH/Coffman)** makes his return to the first team after earning second-team honors last fall. He was named to the first squad in 2003. Oberlin junior **David Wilson (Beaver, PA/Beaver Area)** and Allegheny goalkeeper **Brian Manougian (Rye, NH/Portsmouth Senior)** both make their first-team debut after earning second team honors in 2003. Wilson also had an honorable mention nod in 2002.

Wittenberg defender **Justin Jenkins (Dublin, OH/Coffman)** was selected as Newcomer of the Year and is the only first-year player to appear on the first team. The freshman was part of a defensive unit which shut out four opponents in 19 games this fall and which allowed a measly eight goals in conference play. He also contributed on offense, registering two assists. He and his Wittenberg teammates tied a 10-year-old NCAA record with six tied games this season. The Tigers also earned their first trip to the NCAC Tournament.

Oberlin's **Blake New** is the North Coast's Coach of the Year for the first time. New is 45-59-9 (.438) in his seven seasons at the helm of the Yeomen's program and has compiled an overall record of 68-86-9 (.445) over the span of his 10 year career. Oberlin finished the regular season in second and earned its first berth in the NCAC Tournament.
