**ALL-NCAC EN'S TENNIS SQUAD ANNOUNCED;
TESIC, MORRISON EARN INDIVIDUAL HONORS**

CLEVELAND -- Kenyon junior **Borko Tesic (Amherst, OH/Elyria Catholic)** has been named Player of the Year to highlight the 2004 All-North Coast Athletic Conference men's tennis selections.

Tesic, who compiled a 15-4 record in singles this spring, makes his first appearance on the All-NCAC first team after earning a second-team nod last spring. Tesic is joined on the first team by a trio of repeat first-team honorees - Oberlin senior **Jamie Frankel (West Bloomfield, MI/Bloomfield Hills-Andover)**, Kenyon junior **Mike Herrick (Amherst, OH/Elyria Catholic)** and Wooster senior **Nilesh Saldanha (Bombay, India)**. Herrick and Saldanha are each making their third first-team appearances. Saldanha and Frankel are four-time All-NCAC honorees. Frankel, a first-team member last spring, has also earned second-team and honorable mention honors. In addition to his three first-team appearances, Saldanha, last spring's Player of the Year and the 2001 Newcomer of the Year, also earned a second-team award.

Wabash senior **Mike Lynch (Evansville, IN/Evansville North)** and Wooster freshman **Will Morrison (Delaware, OH/Rutherford B. Hayes)** round out the first team. Lynch earns his third all-league selection after back-to-back second team honors the past two seasons. Morrison was voted the Newcomer of the Year after posting a 10-9 singles record this spring and leading the Fighting Scots to a second-place finish.

Tesic and Herrick head the All-NCAC first team for doubles. They compiled an 9-1 record at first doubles for Kenyon this season. The remainder of the first team consists of Saldanha and junior **Nikhil Gonsalves (Bombay, India)** of Wooster and Lynch and senior **Constantine Alexander (Kokomo, IN/Kokomo)** of Wabash.

Oberlin's **Don Hunsinger** and Wooster's **Hayden Schilling** share the men's tennis Coach of the Year honors for the second time. The two also shared the award after the 1989 season. Hunsinger led the Yeomen to a 15-7 record and a third-place finish -- their best finish since 1990. Hunsinger is 192-197 in his 18 years at the helm of the men's program. He also coaches the women's team, for which he has won this award twice (1989, '97). Schilling earns coaching honors for the fifth time. He guided the Scots to a second-place finish and a 16-8 record. He is 364-211 in his 25 years coaching the men's program. He also coached the Scot women to a 10-10 record this spring.
