NCAC Football Report

**FOUR CONFERENCE GAMES SLATED FOR SATURDAY;
WITTENBERG ROLLS TO PERFECT 8-0 RECORD**

October 22, 2000**

CLEVELAND -- The defending champion Wittenberg Tigers (5-0, 8-0) appear poised to claim their third straight outright North Coast Conference championship. The Tigers welcome the Hiram Terriers (2-3, 2-5) into their lair on Saturday, in one of Wittenberg's last two regular season contests of the year. The Tigers hold a one-game advantage in the short all-time series between the two squads -- this will be only the second-ever meeting between Hiram and Wittenberg.

While Wittenberg is in sole possession of first place, second place is still up for grabs. Allegheny (3-1, 4-3) travels to Wabash (4-1, 5-2) in a game that will go a long way toward further firming up the conference standings. Wabash, who won last week, 49-19 over Hiram, and Allegheny, idle last week, will meet for the first time in the history of the two schools.

Both Wooster (2-2, 4-3) and Oberlin (0-4, 0-7) will look to rebound from last week's losses. The Scots fell to non-conference foe, Ursinus, 31-7; the Yeomen lost a heartbreaker to Kenyon, 12-0. The Lords will try to continue their winning ways when they host Ohio Wesleyan (2-2, 4-3) this week. The Bishops will be anxious to regroup after dropping a 37-7 decision to Wittenberg last week. Ohio Wesleyan and Kenyon have faced each other 31 times since 1899 with the Bishops holding a 21-8-2 record over the Lords.

Denison, which is coming off a loss to Earlham, takes a break from conference play this week when it takes on Case Western Reserve at home. Earlham is idle.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CLEVELAND -- Wabash sophomore **Jake Knott (Lafayette, IN/Jefferson)** and Kenyon junior **Matt Lane (Scituate, MA/Scituate)** have been named offensive and defensive "Players of the Week" for their performances last week in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

Knott, a 6-2, 180-pound quarterback, tossed an NCAC record six touchdown passes in a 49-19 defeat of Hiram. Knott, second in the conference in both total offense and passing average this season, is third on the all-time career passing list at Wabash.

Lane, a 6-2, 240-pound defensive end, totaled 11 tackles in the Lords shutout of Oberlin, including seven solo stops, five tackles for a loss, three sacks for a loss of 23 yards and two forced fumbles. Lane leads the conference after forcing four fumbles this season and is second in sacks with 7.5 in six games.

GRID NOTEBOOK: The latest AFCA Div. III Coaches' poll (Oct. 17) ranks **Wittenberg** fifth ... Denison sophomore quarterback **Greg Neuendorf (Sylvania, OH/Sylvania)** shattered the NCAC -- and Denison -- record for passing yards when he threw for 503 yards against Earlham. His 34 completions set a Big Red record ... Earlham and Denison combined for 1001 yards of total offense ... Quaker junior split end **Will Hughes (Indianapolis, IN/Lawrence North)** caught 10 passes covering 143 yards and scored two TD's on receptions of eight yards apiece. He leads the NCAC averaging 24.8 yards per reception ... Hiram junior quarterback **Tom Gallagher (Strongsville, OH/Brunswick)** picked up 273 yards on 22-of-35 passing against Wabash ... Oberlin junior linebacker **Sam Hobi (Ephraim, UT/Snow College)** recorded a season-high 23 tackles in the Yeomen's loss to Kenyon. He also had one pass breakup, two sacks for a loss of nine yards and three tackles for a loss of 12 yards ... Wittenberg senior kicker **Ryan Walker (Newark, OH/Newark)** had his first three field goals in a month, going three-for-three against Ohio Wesleyan. He is the Wittenberg record-holder in points by kicking, now with 228 in his career ... Senior quarterback **Anthony Crane (Indianapolis, IN/Ben Davis)** is 104 of 185 for 1,536 yards -- all career bests and is on the verge of breaking Tigers season and career records in the next two weeks ... Wooster senior **Seth Duerr (Bolivar, OH/Tuscarawas Valley)** led the Scots in total tackles with 12 against Ursinus. He now has 390 career tackles, breaking Wooster's career record ... Fellow Scot senior **Seth Mastrine (Apple Creek, OH/Waynedale)** picked off his 15th career pass to beat the Scot career interception mark of 14.

**OBERLIN TO HOST CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS SATURDAY;
WOMEN'S SOCCER, VOLLEYBALL ENTER FINAL WEEK OF NCAC PLAY**

CLEVELAND -- Following is a capsule roundup of the NCAC's fall sports action.

CROSS COUNTRY REPORT

The 17th NCAC Championships will be hosted by Oberlin at the Carlisle Reservation in Carlisle, Ohio on Saturday. Kenyon and Denison will be defending their titles from last year. The Lords were crowned men's champs while the Big Red claimed the women's title. In a pre-championship poll of the NCAC Cross Country Coaches, both schools were picked to repeat as champions. The schools must fend off some stiff competition from a number of teams if they want to hold onto their thrones. Wooster was picked to finish second in the men's race, followed closely by Allegheny and Denison. On the women's side, Allegheny was tabbed second, followed by Kenyon and Wooster.

Denison sophomore **Brock Babcock (Platte City, MO/Platte County)**, last year's runner up in the men's race, returns as one of the favorites this year. Other returnees from last year's top 10 finishers include senior **Brice Allen (Sugar Grove, PA/Eisenhower)** from Allegheny, junior **Bill Huffman (Rocky River, OH/Rocky River)** of Wooster and sophomores **Ben Hildebrand (Rochester, NY)** and **Greg Remaly (Bloomsburg, PA/Central Columbia)** of Kenyon. Denison sophomore **Adrienne Shue (Circleville, OH/Circleville)**, who claimed the third spot last year, is the top repeat runner in the women's race. Also running this year are last years' fourth and fifth-place finishers Earlham junior **Shannan Reider (Cincinnati, OH/Mount Notre Dame)** and Denison senior **Susan Bettcher (Strongsville, OH/Strongsville)**.

FIELD HOCKEY REPORT

With one week of conference competition left, Wittenberg (9-1, 12-3) looks to claim its third outright NCAC championship. The Tigers claimed titles in 1996 and '97 and shared the conference crown with Denison in 1998. With

MEN'S CROSS COUNTRY: Wittenberg junior **David Hyde (Naperville, IL/Naperville Central)** led the Tigers to a 13th-place finish at the Wilmington Classic. His time of 27:20 placed him 17th overall.

FIELD HOCKEY: Ohio Wesleyan senior midfielder **Sarah Reisch (St. Louis, MO/Clayton)** found the back of the net twice in the Bishops' win over Kenyon last week. She also assisted on Ohio Wesleyan's first goal against Wittenberg, which gave the Bishops an early lead against the Tigers. Wittenberg rebounded for a 2-1 come-from-behind victory.

MEN'S SOCCER: Earlham senior forward **Chris Wilson (Cambridge, VT/Mansfield Union)** contributed three goals and an assist in two NCAC wins last week. He scored the first two goals in the Quakers' 4-1 win at Wabash and tallied the go-ahead goal and an assist in a 4-2 win over Denison.

WOMEN'S SOCCER: Allegheny sophomore midfielder **Jane Och (Pittsburgh, PA/Upper St. Clair)** scored three goals in two games last week. She notched two in a 5-1 win over Geneva and contributed a goal in the Gators' 4-0 win over Kenyon.

VOLLEYBALL: Denison junior middle hitter **Marti Coval (Gahanna, OH/St. Francis De Sales)** paced the Big Red to three conference wins last week. In 10 games the team captain recorded 29 kills in 62 attempts, 12 blocks and 35 digs.

one and one-half games to remaining on their schedule, Wittenberg holds its destiny in its hands. The Tigers play at Wooster (8-3, 10-5) today, and will resume their contest with Ohio Wesleyan (5-5, 5-9) on Wednesday. The game was suspended earlier this season due to lightning. Wittenberg holds a 1-0 advantage in the game against the Bishops, with a little more than the second half to play. The winner of the NCAC championship earns an automatic bid into the NCAA playoffs.

NCAC teams will participate in the Great Lakes Regional Field Hockey Tournament Saturday and Sunday. The tournament will be hosted by Rhodes College in Memphis, Tenn.

MEN'S SOCCER REPORT

The NCAC race is white hot this week, with all 10 teams again taking the field in conference action. Ohio Wesleyan (8-0, 23 points) has locked up first place and has earned the right to host the inaugural NCAC Men's Soccer Tournament, to be held Friday, November 3 and Saturday, November 4. Positions two through four in the top four tournament have yet to be claimed so decisively, however, making this week's slate of games very important, as teams jockey for the remaining tournament slots. Denison (4-3, 11 points) travels to Hiram (2-4-1, 6 points) on Tuesday to kick things off. Wittenberg (4-3, 12 points) travels to Earlham (4-2-1, 14 points) and Oberlin (3-3-1, 10 points) hosts Wooster (4-3, 11 points) on Wednesday. Saturday's five games finish off the 2000 regular season as Wooster heads to Allegheny (5-2-1, 16 points), Wittenberg travels to Denison, Oberlin hosts Earlham and Hiram and Wabash (0-8, 2 points) host Kenyon (1-7, 4 points) and Ohio Wesleyan, respectively.

Wittenberg (4-3-0, 10-5-1) is 7-2 in games decided by one goal this year. The Tigers' 10 wins exceed their total number of wins for each of the past two years. The last year the team picked up 10 wins was 1997 when they finished with a 10-8-1 record.

National Poll: In the NSCAA poll for Oct. 16, Ohio Wesleyan ranks second in the nation in Division III. The Bishops are the top-ranked team in the Great Lakes Region. Denison is ninth; Wooster received votes.

WOMEN'S SOCCER REPORT

Allegheny College (7-1, 21 points) has earned the top seed in the inaugural NCAC Women's Soccer Tournament. The Gators will host fourth-seeded Wittenberg (4-4, 12 points) at 3:00 p.m. Wednesday. Ohio Wesleyan (7-1, 21 points) earned the second seed and will host third-seeded Denison (7-1, 21 points) at 7:00 p.m. Wednesday. The highest remaining seed after Wednesday's games will host the Tournament Final on Saturday at either 3:00 or 7:00 p.m. All four teams involved in the tournament ended their regular seasons with wins. Allegheny defeated Kenyon (4-4, 12 points), Ohio Wesleyan beat Wooster (4-4, 12 points), Denison defeated Earlham (1-7, 3 points) and Wittenberg beat Hiram (0-8, 0 points).

The Ohio Wesleyan defense held Earlham and Wittenberg to a combined total of eight shots last week as the Bishops posted their sixth and seventh consecutive shutouts in conference play this year. The back line is led by senior **Abby Jenkins (Beavercreek, OH/Carroll)**, juniors **Katie Buchert (Middletown, OH/Middletown)** and **Megan Forman (Sunbury, OH/Big Walnut)**, sophomore **Bre Cady (Westerville, OH/Westerville South)** and freshman **Amy Work (Westerville, OH/Westerville South)**.

National Poll: The NSCAA poll of Oct. 16, ranks Ohio Wesleyan seventh, up from 19th. Denison slips to 17th. The Bishops rank first in the Great Lakes Region while the Big Red are third and Allegheny is fifth. Kenyon also received votes.

VOLLEYBALL REPORT

Wittenberg (8-0, 24-6) has earned the top seed in the eight-team North Coast Athletic Conference Volleyball Championships which will begin with quarterfinal games on Tuesday, October 31. The Tigers will host Hiram (1-7, 8-19). Second-seeded Denison (7-1, 17-9) will host seventh-seeded Kenyon (2-6, 10-20). Third-seeded Allegheny (5-3, 13-17) will entertain Earlham (4-4, 15-10).
