NCAC Spring Sports Update

**KENYON GRABS EARLY LEAD IN MEN'S LACROSSE;
WITTENBERG SOFTBALL BEGINS TITLE DEFENSE SATURDAY**

CLEVELAND -- Following is a capsule roundup of the NCAC's spring sports action.

BASEBALL REPORT

Allegheny (3-0, 13-4) is off to a fast start and leads the East Division through the first weekend of conference action. The Gators take on Hiram (1-1, 9-7) this week. The Terriers are tied for second in the division with Wooster (1-1, 15-6) after they split two games with the Scots last week. Kenyon (0-0, 7-4) opens conference play when it hosts fifth-place Oberlin (0-3, 2-15). The Yeomen are coming off of three losses to Allegheny.

In the West Division, Wittenberg (2-0, 10-4-1) leads after taking a pair from Wabash (0-2, 4-3) last week. Second-place Ohio Wesleyan (2-1, 20-6), which took two of three from Denison (1-2, 8-12), travels to take on the Little Giants this week. Earlham (0-0, 6-11) opens NCAC play this week as they host the Big Red.

Ohio Wesleyan senior catcher **Jason Bogenrife (West Jefferson, OH/West Jefferson)** slammed two home runs to lead the Battling Bishops to a 17-4 defeat of Denison in game three of their series. The homers raise his career total to 43, which breaks the NCAC career mark that was set by Wooster's **Trevor Urban** from 1996-99.

Hiram senior outfielder **Charles Williams (Warren, OH/LaBrae)** hit 5-for-8 (.625) with a double, three runs scored and an RBI as the Terriers split with Wooster. Wittenberg senior outfielder **Ryan Peters (London, OH/London)** hit home runs in both games against Wabash to run his season total to eight in 15 games. Peters has hit safely in 14 of the Tigers' 15 games this season. Denison senior first baseman/pitcher **Derek Johnson (Whittier, CA/La Serna)** hit 5-for-10 (.500) with a run, an RBI and a homerun, and pitched 11.1 innings allowing 15 hits and striking out nine as the Big Red dropped three of four games. Wooster sophomore **Brian Stevens (Canton, OH/Jackson)** hit 8-for-13 (.615) with three doubles, a home run, six RBI and three walks as Wooster won three of four. Wittenberg junior **Brad Cerovac (Brunswick, OH/Brunswick)** pitched his second straight complete-game victory as he gave up three hits and one earned run against Wabash.

Poll: The first ABCA poll (Mar. 27) ranked Allegheny fourth, Ohio Wesleyan ninth and Wooster 22nd.

PLAYER/PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Allegheny sophomore outfielder **Kevin Hiles (Dawson, PA/Connellsville)** hit 8-for-13 (.615) with seven runs scored, a double, a triple, a homerun, nine RBI and three sacrifice flies as the Gators won all five of their games last week, including three in NCAC play. Ohio Wesleyan freshman **Tyler Mott (Grove City, OH/Grove City)** led the Bishops to a 3-1 week with an eight-inning win over Denison that included 10 strikeouts. He also pitched 2.2 innings of relief against Tiffin and allowed no hits to earn a save.

GOLF REPORT

Home is not always sweet. Ohio Wesleyan traded first and third-place finishes last week with Muskingum, winning the Muskies tournament and finishing third at its own. Muskingum returned the favor by winning the Bishops' Strimer Invitational and finishing third at home. Ohio Wesleyan totaled a school-record 576 over 36 holes to lead four North Coast squads at the 11-team Muskingum Invitational. The Bishops first round score of 282 set another school record. Freshman **Chad Poling's (Delaware, OH/Hayes)** was the individual winner, tying a Bishop mark with his 141 total. Wittenberg (fifth), Wooster (seventh), and Kenyon (11th) also competed. Ohio Wesleyan followed the win with a total of 623 over 36 holes to place third, ahead of four other NCAC schools, at the Strimer Invitational. Denison (eighth), Wooster (10th), Wabash (11th) and Hiram (13th) rounded out the league teams competing in the winter-like conditions.

MEN'S LACROSSE REPORT

Kenyon (2-0, 5-1) sits atop the NCAC standings after defeating Wooster (0-1, 0-5) last week. Ohio Wesleyan (1-0, 2-3), which tied with the Lords and Denison (1-1, 4-3) for last year's conference crown, won its conference opener to share the early lead. The Big Red defeated Wittenberg (1-1, 1-3) for their first NCAC victory of the season. Denison senior captain **Sean O'Brien (Mountain Lakes, NJ/Mountain Lakes)** is the leading scorer with 31 points in seven games, and holds the NCAC lead with 16 assists. Right on his heels is Kenyon sophomore **Justin Martinich (Bay Shore, NY/Bay Shore)** with 26 points in six games. Martinich shares the conference lead in goals scored with teammate **Justin Hamilton (Wooster, OH/Wooster)**. Both players have 16 goals in six games. Lord goalkeeper **Greg Clancy (East Falmouth, MA/Falmouth)** has a conference-best .678 saves percentage through last week's competition.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Ohio Wesleyan senior goalkeeper **Corey Ayers (Chattanooga, TN/McCallie School)** made seven saves in the fourth quarter as the Bishops held off a Denison rally in a key NCAC game. Entering the week, the Bishops were ranked 14th in the nation by USILA and the Big Red were sixth. Ayers is second in the conference with a .650 saves percentage.

WOMEN'S LACROSSE REPORT

Denison (1-0, 2-2), Wittenberg (1-0, 3-2) and Wooster (1-0, 2-3) each won their opening North Coast matches to share the early lead in the conference standings. Wittenberg senior **Kati Robbins (Collegeville, PA/Methacton)** tops the NCAC scoring race with 11 goals and 17 assists for 5.60 points per game. Denison senior **Laura Peace (Lutherville, MD/St. Paul's School for Girls)**, last year's NCAC Offensive Player of the Year, is second in scoring with 19 points (4.75 points per game) and is the top goal scorer with 14 goals in four games. Oberlin freshman **Alexis Stoller (Pepper Pike, OH/Laurel)** leads all conference goalkeepers with a .588 saves percentage through five games.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Wittenberg senior **Kati Robbins (Collegeville, PA/Methacton)** scored the game winner in overtime against Oberlin and added four goals and five assists in a non-conference victory over Earlham. Robbins leads the NCAC in points (5.60) and assists (3.40) per game.

SOFTBALL REPORT

The 2001 North Coast season kicks off Saturday with a full slate of games. Wittenberg (6-6) begins defense of their NCAC title at Allegheny (5-10), while Wooster (5-8) travels to Denison (12-4), Ohio Wesleyan (4-9) heads to Hiram (4-10) and Oberlin (0-4) plays at Kenyon (12-4). The Ladies and Big Red top the league with 12 non-conference wins apiece. Kenyon junior pitcher **Denise Darlage (Powell, OH/Olentangy)** leads the conference with a .61 earned run average. Last week she pitched eight and two-thirds innings in two games against Otterbein, throwing a seven-hit shutout in the first game and closing out the second by allowing one run.

PITCHER/PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Kenyon junior **Denise Darlage (Powell, OH/Olentangy)** pitched a seven-hit shutout win against Otterbein, and closed out the second game of the doubleheader, allowing one unearned run. For the week she totaled 8.2 innings, and allowed nine hits and no earned runs as Kenyon went 1-1. Wooster outfielder **Lindsay Vargo (Solon, OH/Solon)** went 8-for-12 (.750) with five doubles and a home run, leading the Scots to a 3-1 mark last week. She went 4-for-4 with two doubles, one homerun, five RBIs and scored three times in a victory over John Carroll.

MEN'S TENNIS REPORT

Allegheny (1-0, 9-3) and Denison (1-0, 6-4) share the lead in the East and West Divisions, respectively, after winning their conference divisional openers last week. The Gators beat Hiram (0-2, 0-5) while the Big Red defeated Ohio Wesleyan (0-1, 1-7). Gator senior **Matt Sowa (Pittsburgh, PA/Shaler)** is undefeated at fifth singles with a 7-0 mark. The Wooster doubles combination of senior **Rob Ogg (Lexington, OH/Lexington)** and junior **Jake Sintich (Aiken, SC/South Aiken)** is off to a solid start with a 5-0 record at number-one doubles. West Division co-leader Wabash (1-0, 11-2) has already won more matches than it did in all of last season (10). Earlham (0-1, 5-4) won four matches last week to move over the .500 mark for the season. Oberlin (1-0, 6-5), co-leader in the East Division, won one of three matches in a rugged Spring Break schedule.

WOMEN'S TENNIS REPORT

Allegheny won two NCAC matches last week to take an early lead in the conference race. The Gators (2-0, 14-2) knocked off Ohio Wesleyan (2-2, 5-4) and Hiram (0-2, 0-4). Five Allegheny singles players are undefeated in NCAC action, and sophomore **Laura Lehrman (Erie, PA/McDowell)**, freshman **Judy Spencer (Pittsburgh, PA/Baldwin)** and sophomore **Jen Schuh (Orchard Park, NY/Hamburg)** are also undefeated overall at fourth, fifth and sixth singles, respectively. Wittenberg (1-0, 6-5) and Denison (1-0, 3-4) won their conference openers over OWU and Wooster (0-2, 4-4). Earlham freshman **Shannon Risacher (Indianapolis, IN/Brebeuf)** is the only other undefeated singles player with a perfect 7-0 mark at number-one singles.

TRACK & FIELD REPORT

The Wooster men didn't exactly lay out the welcome mat at their own invitational last weekend, beating out seven other teams for the win, including fellow NCAC members Denison (third), Allegheny (fourth) and Ohio Wesleyan (seventh). Scot junior **Nahum Kisner (Houston, TX/St. Stephens Episcopal)** won the 100 meters (10.8) and was a member of the winning 400 meter relay team (43.5). Other Wooster first-place finishers included sophomore **Ben Behm (Avon Lake, OH/Avon Lake)** in the 400 meters (50.1), senior **Jacob Johnson (Cleveland Hts, OH/Benedictine)** in the 400 meter hurdles (57.0), junior **Marty Coppola (Medina, OH/Medina)** in the 5000 (15:57.0) and freshman **James Williams (Lorain, OH/Admiral King)** in the long jump (20' 9.75"). The Scots 1600 meter relay team of sophomore **Brian Barnes (Shaker Hts, OH/Shaker Hts)**, Behm, sophomore **Konah Duche (Flushing, NY/Portsmouth Abbey)** and freshman **Jon Kruse (Savannah, OH/Crestview)** also picked up a win (3:26.05). Allegheny sophomore **Jeremy Scott (Norfolk, NE/Norfolk)** paced the Gators with his first-place finish in the pole vault (16' .75"). In the women's field, Denison edged the Scots by 1.5 points to claim first place. Allegheny was fifth and Ohio Wesleyan sixth. Wooster was led by senior **Rachel Dawson (Gibsonia, PA/Hampton)** and freshman **Jessica Love (Chagrin Falls, OH/Kenston)** who won the 5000 meters (18:47.2) and the long jump (14' 4.50"), respectively. Allegheny's **Jen Surace (Bethel Park, PA/Bethel Park)** and **Shaugna Loncar** each took firsts; Surace in the pole vault (10' 2.50") and Loncar in the triple jump (31' 11.75").

Ohio Wesleyan also sent squads to the Big Cat Classic hosted by the University of Memphis and Rhodes College, on the Memphis campus. The Bishop men turned in 25 top-10 finishes, including 14 in the top five, to place second out of 16 teams. Junior **Steve Schoenberger (West Carrollton, OH/West Carrollton)** paced the team with a second-place finish in the javelin and a third-place in the shot put. The Ohio Wesleyan women turned in seven top-10 performances including a third-place finish in the 400 from freshman **Akeya Terrell (Gahanna, OH/Westerville North)**.

Earlham, Kenyon and Wittenberg all competed in non-scoring meets last week. The Quakers opened their outdoor season at the Hanover Invitational with seven first-place finishes. Freshman **Carmen Batts-Porter (Indianapolis, IN/Cardinal Ritter)** broke the Quaker women's shot put record with her first-place toss (37' 1"). She also placed fifth in the javelin (44' 7"). Sophomore **Zach Warren (Charleston, WV/Catholic)** paced the men's team with a win in the 3,000 meter steeplechase (10:02.7). The Lords and Ladies competed at the Cedarville Open. Senior **Vince Evener (Bradford, PA/Greenwood)** and sophomore **Ben Hildebrand (Rochester, NY/Harley)** finished one-two at in the 10,000 meters. Evener (32:31.30) broke the tape mere seconds ahead of his younger teammate (32:37.40) for the win. **Dana Nando** led the Ladies with a third in the 1,500 meters (4:54.30). Wittenberg hosted their own invitational. Junior **Chris Silliman (Columbus, OH/Upper Arlington)** broke his own Tiger record (which he set last week) in the hammer throw (140' 8.50"). Freshman **Geri Woessner (Dayton, OH/Oakwood)**, the first three-sport Tiger athlete in recent years (soccer, basketball and track and field), won the 400 meters (62.80) and placed second in the shot put (31' 4").

RUNNERS OF THE WEEK: Denison senior **Jill Westerfield (Wyoming, OH/Wyoming)** won four events at the Wooster Invitational. Individually, she captured both the 200 (25.6) and the 400 (58.3) meters. She was also a member of two winning relay teams, the 1600 and the 400 (49.0), which met the NCAA provisional qualifying standard. Wooster junior **Nahum Kisner (Houston, TX/St. Stephens Episcopal)** won the 100 meters (10.8) and was a member of the winning 400 meter relay team (43.5). Kisner also earned a second-place finish in the 200 meters (22.4), pacing a quintet of Scot runners who swept places two through six in the event.

FIELD ATHLETES OF THE WEEK: Earlham freshman **Carmen Batts-Porter (Indianapolis, IN/Cardinal Ritter)** broke the Quaker women's shot put record with her first-place toss (37' 1") at the Hanover Invitational. She also placed fifth in the javelin (44' 7"). Allegheny sophomore **Jeremy Scott (Norfolk, NE/Norfolk)** claimed first place in the pole vault at the Wooster Invitational with his NCAA automatic-qualifying (and stadium-record) height of 16' .75".
