**CONFERENCE COMPETITION HEATS UP;
WOOSTER WINS 11 STRAIGHT**

January 7, 2001

CLEVELAND -- The 2000-01 basketball season really starts to get interesting this week, as conference teams settle into their league schedules. The defending North Coast champions, the Wooster Fighting Scots (4-0, 11-0), start things off when they host the Kenyon Lords (3-2, 6-6) on Wednesday. The Scots won all four of their early season NCAC games and look to continue their winning ways. Wooster has rolled to a perfect 11-0 overall record, extending their NCAA-leading 39-game home winning streak. The remaining eight NCAC schools will join Wooster and Kenyon on the court Wednesday. Second-place Wabash (4-1, 6-7) travels to Ohio Wesleyan (3-1, 3-9) while Wittenberg (3-1, 9-2) and Allegheny (0-5, 2-11) host Denison (1-3, 2-10) and Oberlin (0-4, 3-7), respectively. Hiram (2-4, 4-9) plays Case Western Reserve in non-conference action.

This week's schedule ends on Saturday with five conference games on tap. Wooster travels to Wabash, Allegheny visits Denison, Earlham (3-2, 8-5) hosts Oberlin, Kenyon entertains Wittenberg while Hiram and Ohio Wesleyan meet in Delaware. **STOOPS, CHAPPELL NAMED
NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

CLEVELAND -- A pair of Quakers have grabbed this week's conference honors. Earlham sophomore **Nathan Stoops (South Bend, IN/LaSalle)** and freshman **Lindsey Chappell (Highland, In/Highland)** have been named men's and women's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

Stoops, a 6-2 forward, totaled 39 points and eight rebounds last week, handing the Quakers two conference wins with last-second heroics. He capped a 17-point performance against Allegheny by swishing a three-pointer with 25 seconds on the clock. Against Hiram, Stoops finished his 22-point night by hitting a jumper with 45 seconds remaining in the game.

Chappell, a 5-10 forward, scored 56 points, and added 25 rebounds to lead the Quakers to two NCAC wins last week. She contributed 19 points and eight rebounds in a defeat of Denison, then added 19 points and six rebounds in a win over Hiram. Chappell also tallied 18 points and 11 rebounds in a loss to Allegheny. She leads the Quakers this season with 16.2 points and 8.5 rebounds per game.

CLEVELAND -- The North Coast Athletic Conference season shifts into high gear with a full slate of games this week. Highlighting the schedule is a Wednesday night matchup pitting undefeated Ohio Wesleyan (4-0, 9-3) against third-place Wittenberg (3-1, 9-3). The Bishops, who lead the NCAC in all five offensive categories, swept the season series last year. Also this week, OWU will host Hiram (0-5, 1-10) on Wednesday and the Tigers will host Kenyon (2-3, 6-5) on Saturday.

Allegheny (5-0, 10-2) is off to a strong start and the Gators hope to keep their perfect conference mark intact with contests at Oberlin (0-4, 1-11) on Wednesday and at home against Denison (3-2, 7-5) on Saturday. The Big Red, tied for fourth with Earlham (3-2, 7-6) will host seventh-place Wooster (1-4, 3-8) on Wednesday.

Hiram's second-year head coach **Anne Haynam** needs two victories for the 100th win of her 11-year coaching career. In addition to playing at Ohio Wesleyan, the Terriers will host Grove City this week. Oberlin junior **Nzinga Broussard (Delaware, OH/Hayes)** and Ohio Wesleyan junior **Katy Sturtz (Worthington, OH/Watterson)** became the 34th and 35th players, respectively, in NCAC history to reach the 1,000-point plateau. Broussard became the second player in Yeowomen history to score 1,000 career points. Her coach, **Ann Gilbert**, is the only other woman in Oberlin basketball history to reach that mark. Sturtz became the eighth Bishop woman to score 1,000 points. Broussard enters the week as the conference's second-leading scorer this season (16.5 ppg); Sturtz currently leads the conference in field-goal percentage (60.5), rebounds (11.6 per game) and blocked shots (1.33 per game) entering this week's competition.

He qualified in the 200 butterfly with a time of 1:51.27 and in the 100 butterfly in a school-record clocking of 51.63. He is the defending national champion in the 200 fly. Oberlin junior and returning all-America **Celeste Mercer (Montrose, CO/Montrose)** qualified for the NCAA meet in four different events at the Miami Invitational. She met the qualifying standard in the 50 freestyle (24.67), 200 individual medley (2:10.90), 100 butterfly (59.07) and the 100 backstroke (59.48). Her times in the 200 IM and the 100 fly were school records. She was an all-America in the 100 backstroke with a sixth-place finish at the national meet last season ... Wabash completed its two-week training trip to Florida with a 153-44 defeat of Rollins in Winter Park, Florida. The Little Giants took first place in every event but one.
