NCAC Men's Basketball Report

WOOSTER AND WITTENBERG FIGHT FOR FIRST; EARLHAM AND OHIO WESLEYAN WRESTLE OVER THIRD

February 11, 2001**

CLEVELAND -- It looks like the battle for a North Coast Athletic Conference playoff spot will continue right up until the last day of the season. At the top of the standings, Wittenberg (13-1, 19-2) and Wooster (13-1, 20-2) each must get past dangerous opponents early in the week before facing off in a duel for sole possession of first place on Saturday. While the Tigers, winners of 11 straight, travel to Earlham (9-5, 14-8) on Wednesday, the Scots will tip off against Denison (3-11, 4-18).

Earlham, battling for control of the third-place standing with Ohio Wesleyan, finishes the season by traveling to Oberlin (4-10, 7-15) on Saturday. The Bishops (9-5, 9-13) travel to Wabash (8-6, 10-12) midweek and to Allegheny (3-11, 5-17) on Saturday. Wabash, the only NCAC school to not be involved in a tie in the standings, finishes its 2001 campaign at Kenyon (4-10, 7-15) at week's end.

The remaining games slated for this week include Allegheny at Hiram (4-10, 6-16) and Oberlin at Kenyon on Wednesday and Hiram at Denison on Saturday.

NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S BASKETBALL: Oberlin senior **James Knight**, a 6-2 wing, scored 37 points, grabbed 15 rebounds, had five blocks and one assist in two conference wins last week. Knight scored 11 points and snagged eight boards against Hiram and followed with 26 points and a game-high four blocks in Oberlin's first win over Wabash.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL: Wooster sophomore **Nara DeJesus (Geneva, OH/Geneva)**, a 5-10 forward, scored 51 points on 20-of-34 field goal attempts and grabbed 24 rebounds in three games last week. In NCAC play, she tallied 22 points, 14 rebounds and three steals in a near upset of Allegheny. She also scored 19 points and grabbed six rebounds to lead Wooster past Hiram, snapping the Scots 15-game losing streak.

MEN'S INDOOR TRACK: Wabash sophomore **Peter DeYoung (Evansville, IN/Evansville Bosse)** took first place in the high jump at the University of Chicago Invitational. He cleared 6'8", reaching the NCAA provisional height. He added a third-place finish in the long jump with a jump of 20' 7 3/4" to lead the Little Giants to a fifth-place finish in the meet.

WOMEN'S INDOOR TRACK: Denison freshman **Jackie Berner (Fredonia, NY/Fredonia)** turned in double record-setting performances at the Denison Big Red Invitational with wins in the 55 (7.36) and in the 200 (26.34). Both times set Big Red records.

MEN'S FIELD EVENTS: Allegheny junior **Dan Princic (Carrollton, OH/Carrollton)** won the 5000 at Baldwin-Wallace Mid-February Invitational in a Gator-record time of 15:16.00. Allegheny finished third at the event.

WOMEN'S FIELD EVENTS: Denison freshman **Amanda Weiland (Wexford, PA/North Allegheny)** established a Big Red record with her win in the pole vault event at the Denison Big Red Invitational (10' 4.25"). The height also met the NCAA provisional qualifying standard.

CLEVELAND -- As the NCAC heads into the final week of the regular season, the conference's regular-season title is still up for grabs. Allegheny (12-2, 18-4) has a one-game lead over Ohio Wesleyan (11-3, 16-6). After mid-week games with sixth-place Oberlin (5-9, 6-16) and ninth-place Hiram (1-13, 4-18), respectively, the two teams will face off in the season finale on Saturday in Meadville. The Gators are looking for their sixth NCAC title, and first since 1989, while the Bishops have won the past two crowns and hope to pick up their fifth overall. The top-seeded team remaining after the quarterfinals earns the right to host the NCAC tournament semifinals and finals on February 23-24.

There is also a tight race for the third and fourth positions, the winners of which will host quarterfinal games on Tuesday, Feb. 20. Earlham (10-5, 14-9) is coming off of a two-win week and holds a half-game edge over Wittenberg (9-5, 15-7), who also won twice last week, and Denison (9-5, 13-9) for third place. The Quakers' only remaining contest is at Oberlin on Saturday, while the Tigers and Big Red face each other Wednesday night. Kenyon (5-10, 9-13), alone in seventh place but a half-game behind Oberlin, will play their final game Wednesday at eighth-place Wooster (2-12, 4-18).
