**NCAC Men's Basketball Report**

**WITTENBERG WINS NCAC REGULAR SEASON TITLE;  
TIGERS TOPPLE WOOSTER FOR TOP SEED IN NCAC TOURNAMENT**

**CLEVELAND** -- The Wittenberg Tigers (15-1, 21-2), ranked fifth nationally, defeated Division III's top-ranked team, the Wooster Scots (14-2, 21-3), to earn the North Coast regular season title, their first since the 1996-97 season. The Tigers 90-84 win snapped the Scots' NCAA-leading 44-game home winning streak, and also stopped Wooster's string of three consecutive regular season championships. Wittenberg has now won four outright regular season crowns, six overall. The Tigers shared the championship with Allegheny in the 1992-93 season and with Wooster in '91-92. Wittenberg also claimed solo crowns in 1993-94 and '95-96.

The Tigers will be the top seed in the 17th annual NCAC Tournament, which begins with quarterfinals at campus sites on Tuesday. Tuesday's winners will advance to the semifinals and finals on Friday and Saturday at the site of the highest remaining seed. Tournament seeding follows the final regular-season standings (see attached bracket) with the top four seeds hosting the quarterfinals. This year's champion will again receive an automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Tournament.

**NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

**MEN'S BASKETBALL:** Wittenberg junior **Kevin Longley**, a 6-7 wing, totaled 28 points in two key NCAC wins last week. He started the week with 10 points on 5-for-5 shooting from the field as well as eight rebounds and a steal against Earlham and ended the week with a double-double against Wooster. Longley shot 9-for-14 from the field for 18 points and grabbed 17 rebounds against the Scots to lead the Tigers to the NCAC regular-season championship.

**WOMEN'S BASKETBALL:** Ohio Wesleyan senior **Jessica Viertlboeck (Toledo, OH/Whitmer)**, a 5-8 wing, totaled 33 points in two important North Coast wins last week. She led the Bishops with 21 points over Oberlin, then followed by drilling a three-pointer against Allegheny that put Ohio Wesleyan ahead for good and sealed the win with two free throws with :07 remaining in the game. The win placed the Bishops in a tie for first place with Allegheny and makes the Bishops only the third school to win three consecutive NCAC titles.

**MEN'S INDOOR TRACK:** Hiram senior **Bruce Alexander (Youngstown, OH/Girard)** placed second in the 300 (37.39), setting a new Terrier record at the Greater Cleveland Colleges Meet. He won the 55 (6.83) and also anchored the second-place 4 x 400 relay (3:35.09).

**WOMEN'S INDOOR TRACK:** Kenyon senior **Dana Mondo (Long Grove, IL/Stevenson)** won the 1500 at the Denison Big Red Classic with a time of 4:57.43. She crossed the finish line a slim .03 seconds ahead of her nearest competitor.

**MEN'S FIELD EVENTS:** Kenyon senior **Ken McNish (Baltimore, MD/Gilman)** won the triple jump at the Denison Big Red Classic (42' 6.50").

**WOMEN'S FIELD EVENTS:** Hiram sophomore **Emmalisa Brown (Gates Mills, OH/Mayfield)** was second in the high jump (5' 2") at The Greater Cleveland Colleges Meet.

**OHIO WESLEYAN AND ALLEGHENY SHARE NCAC REGULAR SEASON CROWN; BISHOPS EARN TOP SEED IN TOURNAMENT**

**CLEVELAND** -- Ohio Wesleyan (13-3, 18-6) earned their third consecutive North Coast Athletic Conference regular season title, defeating Allegheny (13-3, 19-5) to share the conference crown. The Bishops have now won three outright regular season crowns, five overall. Ohio Wesleyan shared the championship with Wittenberg twice (1998-99 and '91-92 seasons). The Bishops also claimed solo crowns in 1999-00 and '92-93. Allegheny last won a regular season championship in 1988-89, the last of a five-year string of titles.

Ohio Wesleyan will be the top seed in the 17th annual NCAC Tournament, which begins with quarterfinals at campus sites on Tuesday. Tuesday's winners will advance to the semifinals and finals on Friday and Saturday at the site of the highest remaining seed. Tournament seeding follows the final regular-season standings (see attached bracket) with the top four seeds hosting the quarterfinals. This year's champion will again receive an automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Tournament.

**TIME TO TALK TOURNEY:** Wooster leads the way with six men's tournament titles. Only three wins (1995, '99 and '00) came as a #1 seed ... Allegheny (3), Ohio Wesleyan (3), Wittenberg (3) and Kenyon (1) round out the list of past men's champions ... Earlham, this year's third seed, has advanced beyond the quarterfinals once (2000), while Wooster has appeared in the finals nine times. Wittenberg and Allegheny have each made seven appearances ... Hiram and Wabash will be making their second tournament appearances in as many years. The Terriers and Little Giants both joined the conference last year. Wabash advanced through the 2000 tournament, defeating both Ohio Wesleyan and Wittenberg before falling in the championship game to Wooster... Allegheny (5) and Wittenberg (5) have combined to win 10 of 16 women's tournament titles ... Ohio Wesleyan and Kenyon have two championships, while Denison and Wooster each have one ... Earlham, this year's sixth seed, and Oberlin, the seventh seed, have never advanced beyond the semifinals, while Ohio Wesleyan and Wittenberg, the fourth seed, have each made the finals nine times.

On the men's side, senior **Alex Rosenzweig (Chicago, IL/Avon Old Farms)** was a double winner for Denison. He took the 55 meters in 6.65 and the 200 meters in 23.40 as Denison won six events. Kenyon senior **Ken McNish (Baltimore, MD/Gilman)** was the lone winner for the Lords when he took first in the triple jump (42-6 1/2) ... WABASH placed third of 13 teams at the DePauw Invitational. Sophomore **Peter DeYoung (Evansville, IN/Evansville Bosse)** scored a first-place finish in the high jump when he cleared 6 feet, 6 inches ... At Ohio Northern Friday night, OHIO WESLEYAN's men placed 10th and WOOSTER's men were 12th in the 13-team meet. In the women's competition, Wooster was sixth, EARLHAM, seventh and Ohio Wesleyan was eighth of 14 teams. Earlham freshman **Jessica Holland (Lawrenceburg, IN/Oldenburg Academy)** won the women's 400 meters in school-record time (1:04.78). Senior **Amy Stafford (New Carlisle, OH/Tecumseh)** of Ohio Wesleyan won the women's pole vault with a ONU Sports Center-record height of 9 feet, 6 1/4 inches. Wooster senior **Justina Williams (Moreno Valley, CA/El Camino Real)** was a double winner, taking both the triple jump (34-10 1/4) and long jump (17-9). Her long-jump mark set a school record by almost six inches.
