### **NCAC Men's Basketball Report**

### **WOOSTER EDGES WITTENBERG FOR SEVENTH NORTH COAST**

### **TOURNAMENT TITLE; SCOTS AND TIGERS ADVANCE TO NCAA TOURNEY**

**For Immediate Release**

**February 26, 2000**

**CLEVELAND** -- North Coast Athletic Conference Tournament Champion Wooster (14-2, 24-3) has received a bid to the NCAA Division III Tournament for the 14th time. The Scots, who earned their seventh NCAC Tournament title over the weekend, will host the winner of Thursday's Marian (Wis.) (17-10) at Carthage (21-4) matchup in a second-round contest on Saturday, March 3. NCAC Tournament runner-up Wittenberg (15-1, 23-3) also received a first-round bye and will host the winner of Thursday's matchup between MacMurray (14-10) and Maryville (Tenn.) (22-4). The Tigers advance to the Div. III Tournament for the first time since 1997.

Wooster's NCAC tournament run featured wins against Hiram, Earlham and Wittenberg. Sophomore forward **Bryan Nelson (Kettering, OH/Kettering Fairmont)** scored a career-high 31 points to lead the Scots to a 59-56 victory over the Tigers in the final. He averaged 23 points and 10 rebounds in the three games to earn the Al Van Wie Award as the tournament's Most Outstanding Performer. Wooster has now won four of the last five NCAC Tournament titles; last week's win capped a run of three consecutive crowns.

### **NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

**MEN'S BASKETBALL:** Wooster sophomore **Bryan Nelson (Kettering, OH/Kettering Fairmont)**, a 6-4 forward, totaled 68 points to lead the Scots to their third straight NCAC Tournament title. He also combined for 30 rebounds, four assists and three steals on his way to being named the tournament's Most Outstanding Performer.

**WOMEN'S BASKETBALL:** Ohio Wesleyan senior **Jessica Viertlboeck (Toledo, OH/Whitmer)**, a 5-8 wing, totaled 74 points to lead the Bishops to their third NCAC Tournament title. She also combined for 19 rebounds, eight assists and seven steals on her way to being named the tournament's Most Outstanding Performer.

**MEN'S INDOOR TRACK:** Wittenberg senior **Josh Guerrieri (Avon, OH/Avon)** won the 55-meter hurdles at the DePauw Invitational (7.90). He also finished sixth in the 200 (23.67).

**WOMEN'S INDOOR TRACK:** Wittenberg junior **Sarah Weide (Ft. Wayne, IN/Homestead)** won the 600 at the DePauw Invitational, beating her nearest competitor by five seconds. Her time of 1:39.79 established a Tiger record. She also ran with the first-place distance medley relay team (12:22.27) which shattered the old school record by 25 seconds.

**MEN'S FIELD EVENTS:** Allegheny sophomore **Jeremy Scott (Norfolk, NE/Norfolk)** won the pole vault event at Oberlin with a fieldhouse record height of 15 feet, six inches. He also placed second in the high jump (6' 6").

**WOMEN'S FIELD EVENTS:** Allegheny freshman **Lindsey Hayes (Little silver, NJ/Red Bank)** tied for first in the high jump (5' 3") and placed second in the long jump (15' 8") at Oberlin.

**CLEVELAND** -- North Coast Athletic Conference Tournament Champion Ohio Wesleyan (13-3, 21-6) has received a bid to the NCAA Division III Tournament for the fourth time. The Bishops, who earned their third NCAC Tournament title over the weekend, will travel to Lake Forest (20-4) on Wednesday. The Ohio Wesleyan-Lake Forest winner will advance to play Hope (25-2) in Michigan on Saturday, March 3. Wednesday's other first-round contests feature Thomas More (13-11) at Centre (20-5) and Christopher Newport (15-11) at Maryville (21-4). The winners of those two contests will face off on Saturday.

Ohio Wesleyan's NCAC Tournament run featured wins over Wooster, Wittenberg and Earlham. Senior wing **Jessica Viertlboeck (Toledo, OH/ Whitmer)** scored a game-high 30 points to lead the Bishops to an 87-76 overtime win over the Quakers in the final. Nelson was joined on the All-Tournament team by fellow Scot **Antwyan Reynolds (Mansfield, OH/Mansfield Senior)**, a junior. Rounding out the squad were Earlham sophomore **Nathan Stoops (South Bend, IN/LaSalle)**, Ohio Wesleyan freshman **Travis Schwab (Medina, OH/Medina Senior)** and a pair of Wittenberg Tigers: junior **Kevin Longley (Vandalia, Ohio/Butler)** and senior **Ryan Taylor (Waynesfield, OH/Goshen)** ... Ohio Wesleyan senior **Jessica Viertlboeck (Toledo, OH/Whitmer)** received the Al Van Wie Award as Most Valuable Player at the 2001 Women's NCAC Tournament. Viertlboeck was joined on the All-Tournament team by a pair of teammates, junior **Katy Sturtz (Worthington, OH/Columbus Watterson)** and senior **Anissa Haynes (Columbus, OH/Bishop Hartley)**.
