**WOOSTER AND WITTENBERG CONTINUE BATTLE FOR FIRST;
TWO WEEKS REMAIN IN REGULAR SEASON**

CLEVELAND -- With four games to left to play on each North Coast schedule, the next two weeks will be filled with pulse-pounding, teeth-grinding, nerve-wracking basketball. Each and every time two teams tipoff, a playoff spot is at stake. The action starts Wednesday, with a full slate of five games. Ohio Wesleyan (9-3, 9-11) tries to solidify its third-place standing when the Bishops host fifth-place Earlham (7-5, 12-8). The Quakers, on the other hand, are gunning for the fourth seed in the tournament, and a win Wednesday would help them on their way.

Wooster (11-1, 18-2) and Wittenberg (11-1, 17-2) continue their battle for first. The Scots travel to Allegheny (3-9, 5-15), while the Tigers look to continue their nine-game winning streak when they host fourth-place Wabash (8-4, 10-10). Both the Gators and the Little Giants are fighting to better their tournament prospects and could prove to be dangerous opponents for the two front-runners. At the opposite end of the standings, Oberlin (2-10, 5-15) and Denison (2-10, 3-17) need wins to keep tournament play within their grasp. The Yeomen host Hiram (3-9, 5-15); the Big Red host Kenyon (4-8, 7-13).

NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S BASKETBALL: Wooster sophomore **Bryan Nelson (Kettering, OH/Kettering Fairmont)**, a 6-4 forward, scored 44 points and grabbed 22 rebounds as the Scots won twice last week. Against Kenyon, he scored 21 points, grabbed 12 rebounds, had three assists and stole two passes. He followed with a 23-point, 10-rebound effort against Wabash.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL: Ohio Wesleyan senior **Leslie Welsh**, a 5-7, guard, totaled 36 points, seven steals and five rebounds as the Bishops improved their NCAC record to 10-2. She finished the week shooting 12-19 (.632) from the field. Her 18 points, including two late free throws, sealed OWU's overtime win over Denison.

MEN'S INDOOR TRACK: Denison sophomore **Tyler Pensyl (Westerville, OH/Westerville North)** won the 800 meters at the Ohio Northern Midwest Elite Meet with a time of 1:57.22. He was one of two Big Red athletes to claim event wins at the meet.

WOMEN'S INDOOR TRACK: Wittenberg sophomore **Abi Gerstle (Kettering, OH/Kettering Fairmont)** was a double winner at the Ohio Northern Midwest Elite Meet. She outdistanced opponents in both the 1500 (5:04.13) and the 1000 (3:11.26) by more than four seconds.

MEN'S FIELD EVENTS: Ohio Wesleyan junior **Pete Tsickritzis (Plymouth, MA/Bridgton Academy)** won both the long jump (19 feet. 10.25 inches) and the high jump (6' 4") competitions at the OWU February Invitational on Feb. 2. The following day, he tied for second in the high jump (6' 2.25") at the Ohio Northern Midwest Elite Meet.

WOMEN'S FIELD EVENTS: Wooster senior **Justina Williams (Moreno Valley, CA/El Camino Real)** returned from an injury to lead the Scots at Case Western Reserve by winning both the long jump (17') and the triple jump (34' 3"). She also competed in the high jump, finishing sixth (4' 8").
