WITTENBERG AND WOOSTER REMAIN UNDEFEATED;

January 13, 2002

TIGERS AND SCOTS TO HOST THIRD AND FOURTH PLACE TEAMS WEDNESDAY

CLEVELAND -- Two North Coast Athletic Conference teams enter the week with six league wins and no losses to conference foes. Defending champion Wittenberg (6-0, 13-2) and 2001 NCAC Tournament winner Wooster (6-0, 12-3) share first place and must face off against the teams in the third and fourth-place spots on Wednesday. The Tigers host third-place Ohio Wesleyan (5-1, 9-6) in the first of two matchups between the teams this winter. Last season, the Bishops won the first regular season meeting of the two teams, in Delaware, but fell to Wittenberg in their second meeting, on the Tigers' home court. Wittenberg also topped the Bishops in the semifinal round of the NCAC Tournament in Springfield. Meanwhile, Wooster will host fourth-place Allegheny (4-2, 8-5) in their first meeting of the season. Last winter, the Scots swept both contests against the Gators. Also on tap for Wednesday: Denison (2-4, 2-13) travels to Hiram (0-6, 2-13), Wabash (3-3, 6-8) plays at Earlham (2-4, 7-8) and Oberlin (1-5, 2-12) visits Kenyon (1-5, 3-11).

All 10 NCAC teams will also take the court on Saturday with five league contests scheduled.

SNYDER, MCCONNELL NAMED NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CLEVELAND -- Wooster sophomore **Ryan Snyder (Sebring, OH/Sebring McKinley)** and Denison sophomore **Jessica McConnell (Newark, OH/Lakewood)** and have been named men's and women's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

Snyder, a 6-1 guard, who began the week with 50 points and 29 rebounds in 12 games this year, totaled 45 points on 16-of-28 field-goal shooting and 16 rebounds. He also made 5-of-12 three-pointers and 8-of-10 free throws, while recording five assists, a block, and two steals in leading Wooster to three overall wins and two NCAC victories. On Monday, Snyder scored a season-high 21 points and grabbed a career-high eight boards against Westminster. Then, he had a perfect shooting night on Wednesday, making all three field goals, including a three, and all four from the charity stripe for 11 points in 19 minutes against Oberlin. On Saturday, Snyder had a balanced game with 13 points, six rebounds, and four assists.

McConnell, a 5-6 guard, led the Big Red to two NCAC wins with 24 points, nine rebounds, four assists, two steals and a block. Against Kenyon, she tallied a game-high 11 points to go with four rebounds and an assist and a block. McConnell scored seven of 19 points in a 19-0 run in the middle of the first half to seal the win against Hiram. She finished with 13 points, five boards, three assists and two steals.
