WITTENBERG AND WOOSTER REMAIN UNDEFEATED; TIGERS AND SCOTS FACE OFF SATURDAY

January 20, 2002

CLEVELAND -- With the bulk of the first half of the conference schedule in the scorebook, North Coast teams now know what to expect from each opponent remaining on their schedules. Each and every contest is expected to be intense as bragging rights, as well as the rights to home-court advantage in the season-ending NCAC Tournament, are on the line. The current league leaders, Wittenberg (8-0, 15-2) and Wooster (8-0, 14-3), face off for the first time this season on Saturday. Last season, the Tigers swept both meetings between the two squads during the regular season, while the Scots triumphed in the conference tournament. After Saturday, the two teams must fend off the bulk of the conference before they meet for the second time on the last weekend of the regular season.

Before Wittenberg and Wooster meet this weekend, they must survive a midweek road game. On Wednesday, the Tigers travel to fourth-place Wabash (4-4, 7-9) while the Scots head to third-place Ohio Wesleyan (6-2, 10-7). Allegheny (4-4, 8-7), Kenyon (2-6, 4-12) and Oberlin (2-6, 3-13) also travel on Wednesday. The Gators, tied with Wabash for fourth, play Hiram (1-7, 3-14), while the Lords visit Earlham (2-6, 7-10) and the Yeomen match up against Denison (3-5, 3-14).

MAYLE, MKELLER NAMED NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CLEVELAND -- Hiram junior **David Mayle (Ravenna, OH/Crestwood)** and Wittenberg junior **Tiffany Keller (Massillon, OH/Tuslaw)** have been named men's and women's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

Mayle, a 6-4 wing, scored a career-high 29 points in an 86-80 overtime win over Kenyon - to hand the Terriers their first league win of the season. He also grabbed five rebounds against the Lords. In a loss to Denison, Mayle compiled 22 points and snagged eight boards. For the week, he totalled 51 points and 13 rebounds.

Keller, a 5-10 forward, scored 16 points and pulled down 13 rebounds, including seven on the offensive end, against Kenyon. The double-double was her second straight since entering the starting lineup for just the second time this season earlier this month. Then against Wooster, Keller contributed her fourth straight double-figure scoring total with 14 points and four rebounds.

SWIM SCENE: Allegheny was swept by Westminster last week. **Megan Bush (Ligonier, PA/Ligonier Valley)** was a double winner with victories in the 50 freestyle (25.58) and 100 freestyle (55.40), and was part of the winning 200 freestyle relay. **Matt Wilson (Altoona, PA/Altoona Area)** led the men's squad as he took the 100 breaststroke (1:03.83) and was part of the winning 200 freestyle relay ... Kenyon's men took a narrow defeat at the hands of Division I opponent Miami (Ohio), 119-102. **Read Boon (Durham, NC/C.E. Jordan)** led the Lords with first-place finishes in the 50 free (21.40) and 100 free (46.42), and anchored the winning 400 free relay. The Ladies lost to Ohio State and Miami last week. **Beth Galloway (Orchard Park, NY/Orchard Park)** won the 50 free against Ohio St. (23.97) and Miami (23.91) and also took the 100 free vs. Miami (52.54) ... Wabash lost a dual meet for the first time this season, falling to Washington (Mo.). Diver **Aaron Stump (Valparaiso, IN/Valparaiso)** produced career bests in both diving events, scoring 218.95 points in the one-meter diving and 215.55 points in the three-meter. He placed second in both competitions ... Wittenberg's men and women each lost to Div. I Wright State. Sophomore **Steve Rader (Concord, OH/St. Ignatius)** won the 100 butterfly (53.70) and senior **Jeremy Lazarus (Moens, France/Ferney-Voltaire)** won the 100 breast (1:02.98). Senior **Rachel Juergens (Springfield, OH/Catholic Central)** was a double winner as she finished first in the 400 individual medley (4:42.55) and 500 free (5:11.55) ... Wooster swept men's and women's dual meets over Ohio Wesleyan. Scot head coach **Keith Beckett** became the school's all-time leader for men's dual-meet victories, as he improved to 107-45. He surpassed **Carl Munson**, who went 106-100 from 1922-52. Beckett is already Wooster's winningest women's coach with a 134-19-1 mark.

TRACK TALK: The indoor track & field season officially begins on Saturday with the NCAC Relays, hosted by Denison University. Denison's men and women are the defending champions. In tuneups last week, Allegheny, Hiram, Kenyon and Oberlin competed in a non-scoring meet at Baldwin-Wallace. In the men's meet, the Gators' **Joe Yarkovic (Herminie, PA/Greensburg Central Catholic)** won the 55 meters (6.70), Oberlin's **Greg Wells (Durham, CT)** was victorious in the long jump (20-11) and Kenyon's **Cary Snyder (Charlotte, NC/Northern Valley, NJ)** took the 1000 meters (2:37.75). On the women's side, Allegheny's **Lindsey Shouey (Franklin, PA/Franklin)** won the 1500 meters (5:02.60) and **Leigh Seserko (Allison Park, PA/Shaler Area)** the 800 meters (2:29.39) and Oberlin's **Courtney Stackhouse (Woodbridge, VA/Bishop Ireton)** won the 55 meters (7.50) ... Ohio Wesleyan competed in a non-scoring meet at Ashland. Senior **Craig Neeley (Columbus, OH/Bexley)** won the triple jump (42-8) and high jump (6-6).

BISHOPS' BARNES NAMED NATIONAL COACH OF YEAR: Ohio Wesleyan women's soccer coach **Bob Barnes** was named NSCAA/adidas Coach of the Year for NCAA Div. III, it was announced at the National Soccer Coaches Association of America convention in Philadelphia. Barnes guided OWU to its first-ever NCAA Div. III national championship this past fall. He also garnered Coach of the Year honors from the NCAC and the Ohio Collegiate Soccer Association. The Bishops won their third straight NCAC crown and their second straight Great Lakes Regional title on the way to the national championship. OWU posted a 22-1 record, setting school and conference records for wins in a season.
