WITTENBERG AND WOOSTER CONTINUE TO BATTLE FOR FIRST; TIGERS AND SCOTS SUFFER FIRST NCAC LOSSES

January 27, 2002

CLEVELAND -- Reigning NCAC Champion Wittenberg (9-1, 16-3) finds itself in the midst of a close race toward the number one spot in the season-ending North Coast Athletic Conference Tournament. Heading into this week, the Tigers are tied with Wooster (9-1, 15-4) for first-place. Both teams must fend off the challengers nipping at their heels. Wittenberg travels to Earlham (3-7, 8-11) on Wednesday and returns home to host fifth-place Allegheny (5-5, 9-8) on Saturday. The Scots have the opposite schedule this week, hosting Hiram (1-9, 3-16) Wednesday and heading to Kenyon (2-8, 4-14) on Saturday. Both teams suffered their first league losses of the season last week, Wittenberg briefly fell into second place with a 77-65 loss to Wabash, but then rebounded to beat Wooster, 75-70, and regain a share of first place.

A total of 10 conference games fill this week's schedule, as each team takes the court twice. Wednesday's slate will see third-place Ohio Wesleyan (7-3, 11-8) at Wabash, Kenyon (2-8, 4-14) at Denison (4-6, 4-15) and Oberlin (4-6, 5-13) at Allegheny. On Saturday, the Yeomen host Earlham, while, Denison and Hiram welcome Wabash and Ohio Wesleyan, respectively.

NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S BASKETBALL: Oberlin sophomore **Cameron Leverett (Columbus, OH/Northland)** a 5-7 guard, scored 40 points, grabbed eight rebounds, dished off seven assists and had four steals in two NCAC wins last week. The Yeomen were one of only two teams to go undefeated last week and have now won three straight league games.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL: Oberlin senior **Nzinga Broussard (Delaware, OH/Hayes)**, a 5-7 guard, averaged 23 points, nine steals, eight and 1/2 rebounds and six assists in two NCAC games last week. She scored a game-high 24 points in a loss to Denison and followed with 22 in a win over Earlham. Her efforts pushed her to the top of the Oberlin all-time scoring list, past head coach **Ann Gilbert**, with 1,535 points.

MEN'S INDOOR TRACK: The Wittenberg 55 Meter Hurdles Relay, composed of sophomores **Skip Ivery (Columbus, OH/Groveport Madison)** and **Derek Thompson (South Charleston, OH/Greenon)** won the NCAC Indoor Track Relay with a time of 16:09. Ivery ran a personal best time of 7.84; Thompson turned in an 8.25 performance.

WOMEN'S INDOOR TRACK: Allegheny's Distance Medley Relay, composed of freshmen **Leah and Lindsey Shouey (Franklin, PA/Franklin)**, and sophomores **Brooke Woods (Pittsburgh, PA/Avonworth)** and **Lindsey Hayes (Little Silver, NJ/Red Bank)** set a Gator and an NCAC Indoor Track Relays record with a time of 12:38.43. Their times also met NCAA Provisional Qualifying standards.

MEN'S FIELD EVENTS: Wooster won the Shot Put Relay at the NCAC Indoor Track Relays with a distance of 90 feet, 11 inches. Sophomore **Keith Vance (Mt. Vernon, OH/Mt. Vernon)** recorded a distance of 46 feet, one and 1/2 inches while freshman **Eric Seling (Wooster, OH/Wooster)** threw for a distance of 44 feet, nine and 1/2 inches.

WOMEN'S FIELD EVENTS: Ohio Wesleyan won the Shot Put Relay at the NCAC Indoor Track Relays with a distance of 73 feet, 10 and 3/4 inches. Senior **Becky Osbourne (Sandy Hook, CT/Newtown)** recorded a distance of 38 feet, nine and 1/2 inches while teammate sophomore **Fay Barry (Reynoldsburg, OH/Reynoldsburg)** achieved a personal record of 35 feet, one and 1/4 inches.
