**NCAC Football Report**

**OHIO WESLEYAN AND WITTENBERG SHARE FIRST IN NCAC;  
BISHOPS REMAIN UNBEATEN AT 5-0 OVERALL**

**CLEVELAND** -- The race for the 2001 North Coast championship features much jockeying for position as the 10 competitors reach the halfway mark of the season. With five conference games slated for the week, NCAC fans could very well see a shuffle at the top of the league standings.

Ohio Wesleyan (2-0, 5-0) and Wittenberg (3-0, 5-1) will try to retain their hold on first place when they line up against Denison (1-2, 1-4) and Wooster (1-2, 1-3), respectively on Saturday. The Bishops, the only undefeated team in the league, are off to their best start since 1992. Ohio Wesleyan continued its roll through the season with a 45-10 defeat of Earlham last week. The Bishop defense clamped down on the Quakers in the battle of unbeatens in the NCAC. Ohio Wesleyan held Earlham to minus 23 yards total offense on its first four possessions, forcing turnovers in Quaker territory 3 times and scoring off all 3 turnovers. Senior halfback **Matt (Capone (Cleveland, OH/Padua))** led the Bishops with 121 yards in 19 rushes and 5 receptions for 35 yards. He also returned 2 kicks for 70 yards to total 226 all-purpose yards. The Tigers picked up their 25th straight NCAC win when they topped Denison, 72-14, last week.

Wabash (2-1, 3-2), currently tied for third with Allegheny (2-1, 2-3), puts its two-game win streak on the line against Earlham (1-1, 2-3) this week. The Little Giants host a Quaker squad looking to rebound from its first conference loss of the fall. The Gators, looking to keep their winning momentum, travel this week, heading to Kenyon (0-2, 0-4). Allegheny defeated Hiram, 57-0, last week. The Wabash defense came up with nine sacks and forced four turnovers on the way to a 35-7 homecoming victory over Wooster last week. The Little Giants held the Scots to 64 yards of total offense in the first half as the offense put 28 points on the scoreboard to thrill more than 4,100 fans on hand to celebrate the homecoming activities.

Hiram (0-2, 2-2) entertains Oberlin (0-1, 0-4) to round out the week's schedule. The Terriers look to rebound from their loss to Allegheny, while the Yeomen return to action after sitting out last week.

**PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

**CLEVELAND** -- Ohio Wesleyan junior **Bernie Vendlinski (Brunswick, OH/Highland)** and Wabash junior **Josh Stanton (Mooreville, IN/Mooreville)** have been named offensive and defensive "Players of the Week" for their performances last week in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

**Vendlinski**, a 5-10, 205-pound halfback, ran the ball into the endzone three times, propelling the Bishops to a 45-10 win over Earlham and their first 5-0 start since 1992. Vendlinski is Ohio Wesleyan's third highest rusher, averaging 59 yards per game.

**Stanton**, a 5-11, 205-pound linebacker, piled up a career-high three and one-half sacks (33 yards) and a career-best four tackles for losses totaling 34 yards while making five solo tackles and five assisted tackles for a total seven and one-half tackles in the Little Giants 35-7 win over Wooster. He forced two fumbles and recovered his second fumble of the season.

**GRID NOTEBOOK:** Allegheny quarterback **Bubba Smith (Doylestown, OH/Chippewa)** completed 14-of-24 passes for a career-high 244 yards in the Gators' win over Hiram. The sophomore tied the Allegheny single-game record for touchdown passes with five, equaling the mark set by **Mike Ganey** in a 79-30 win over Carnegie Mellon on Oct. 18, 1969. Smith also rushed nine times for 37 yards ... Linebackers **Robert** and **Rodney Gunn (South Bend, IN/Lasalle)**, brothers on the Earlham roster, combined for 26 total tackles against Ohio Wesleyan. Robert, a senior, recorded 13 unassisted stops and two assists while Rodney, a junior, piled up seven solos and four assists ... Hiram junior defensive back **Jon Pascarella (Youngstown, OH/Ursuline)** recorded 11 total tackles against Allegheny, including seven solo stops ... Kenyon senior running back **Neil Hall (St. Louis Park, MN/St. Louis Park)** rushed for 62 yards and a touchdown against Case Western Reserve. He also caught three balls for 49 yards. Freshman linebacker **Casey McConnell (Cincinnati, OH/Summit Country Day)** made a game-high 16 tackles against CWRU ... The Ohio Wesleyan defense recorded eight sacks against Earlham, with senior defensive tackle **Steve Schoenberger (West Carrollton, OH/East Carrollton)** and sophomore defensive end **Travis Little (Wheelersburg, OH/)** getting two apiece ... Wittenberg got two and one-half sacks from senior defensive tackle **Juan Howard (Wooster, OH/Wooster)** and 11 sacks total against Denison. (Wittenberg record is 16). The Tigers scored the most points in a game since they recorded 77 in 1995 at Oberlin. Tailback **Alex Smith (Blue Bell, PA/Germantown Academy)** amassed 107 yards and two touchdowns on 19 carries in his first college appearance. The freshman nearly missed the bus for the game - his first road trip, forgot his jersey and had to wear sophomore wide receiver **Skip Ivery's (Columbus, OH/Groveport Madison)** No. 1, and only played in the third and fourth quarters of the game.

**KENYON CROSS COUNTRY WINS SECOND STRAIGHT MEN'S ALL-OHIO TITLE;  
DENISON AND OHIO WESLEYAN TO MEET IN WOMEN'S SOCCER**

**October 7, 2001**

**CLEVELAND** -- Following is a capsule roundup of the NCAC's fall sports action.

**CROSS COUNTRY REPORT**

Nine of 10 North Coast squads will line up Saturday at Invitational meets in Indiana, New York and Pennsylvania. Allegheny will compete at Rochester, and Kenyon will participate in the Ohio Bobcat Invitational. Hiram and Denison will run at Duquesne, while Oberlin and Ohio Wesleyan will compete at Ohio Northern. Earlham, Wabash and Wittenberg will race at Manchester. Wooster is idle next weekend.

Fourteen of the 19 North Coast squads competed at the All-Ohio Intercollegiate Championships at Ohio Wesleyan last Friday. The Kenyon men's squad took first place among Division III schools for the second year in a row, seventh overall, followed by Wooster (21st overall) in eighth. The Lords' **Ben Hildebrand (Fairport, NY/The Harley School)** was the first Div. III runner to cross the line; he placed fifth in the overall race (26:10). The Scots' top individual, junior **Brendan Callahan (South Glastonbury, CT/Glastonbury)**, took second in the Div. III race and 12th overall (26:26.5). Other NCAC team finishes in the Div. III race were Denison (24th), Oberlin (25th), Wittenberg (26th), Ohio Wesleyan (30th) and Hiram (31st). Terrier senior **Don Beesing (Stow, OH/Stow)** placed 12th among Division III runners, 49th in a field of 223 (27:12.6).

On the women's side, Oberlin was the top NCAC team at the All-Ohio meet. The Yeowomen placed fourth among Division III schools, 17th overall. Wittenberg junior **Abi Gerstle (Kettering, OH/Fairmont)** was the first North Coast runner across the line, placing fourth in Div. III, 40th overall in the field of 239 (19:42.9). In all, four NCAC schools placed in the top 10, including Denison in fifth, Kenyon in seventh and Wittenberg in ninth. Wooster was 13th, followed by Ohio Wesleyan in 14th and Hiram in 16th. **MEN'S CROSS COUNTRY:** Kenyon junior **Ben Hildebrand (Fairport, NY/The Harley School)** won the Division III class of the All-Ohio Intercollegiate Championships at Ohio Wesleyan last Friday. His time of 26:10 placed him fifth overall in a field of 223. Kenyon won the Div. III meet for the second year in a row and placed seventh overall in the 33-team race.

**WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY:** Wittenberg senior **Sarah Weide (Ft. Wayne, IN/Homestead)** was the second NCAC woman to cross the finish line at the 35-team All-Ohio Intercollegiate Championships at Ohio Wesleyan last Friday. Her time of 20:03 helped earn her a ninth-place finish in the Division III portion of the race and a 40th-place standing overall in a field of 239.

**FIELD HOCKEY:** Kenyon freshman forward/midfielder **Julia Wickham (Columbus, OH/Grandview Heights)** had a hand in all three Ladies' goals during a 3-2 win over Earlham. She scored the first goal of the game and then assisted on the other two, lifting Kenyon to their first win of the season.

**MEN'S SOCCER:** Wabash junior forward **Carlos Aguirre (Indianapolis, IN/Ben Davis)** scored four goals in three games this week, including two goals against Wooster on Saturday, to lead the Little Giants to a 2-1 record for the week. Aguirre has scored six goals in the last seven games and has 13 points in his last seven starts for Wabash.

**WOMEN'S SOCCER:** Ohio Wesleyan junior forward **Emily Bayer (Medina, OH/Medina)** netted the gamewinning goal and added an assist in the Bishops 4-0 win over Mt. Saint Joseph. She also scored the gamewinner over Earlham.

**VOLLEYBALL:** Wooster freshman **Kelly McAllister (West Chester, OH/Mt. Notre Dame)** led Wooster to a 2-1 week, including an NCAC tri-match sweep, with 46 kills and 27 digs. Her week was highlighted by a 32-kill performance in a five-match marathon against Ohio Wesleyan. She also had 11 digs and two blocks against the Bishops. McAllister had nine digs, two kills and two service aces against Oberlin, as well as 12 kills and seven digs at Otterbein.

**FIELD HOCKEY REPORT**

This week, conference leaders Wittenberg (6-1, 8-1) and Wooster (6-1, 9-2) try to strengthen their respective grips on the top spot in the NCAC standings. Wittenberg takes the field on Tuesday at Oberlin (3-5, 4-5), on Thursday at home against Ohio Wesleyan (4-4, 6-6) and on Saturday at Denison (3-4, 3-9). Wooster only plays twice this week, with both games at home. The Scots host Kenyon (2-4, 2-6) on Wednesday and Oberlin on Saturday. Three additional games are scheduled this week: Earlham (1-6, 2-8) travels to Ohio Wesleyan on Tuesday and hosts Kenyon Saturday, while Denison visits Oberlin on Thursday.

**Notes:** Kenyon defeated Denison, 1-0, last week, the first time the Ladies beat the Big Red since 1997 ... Ohio Wesleyan freshman **Meredith Bynum (Winston-Salem, NC/Forsyth Country Day)** figured in both goals in the Bishops 2-1 win over Oberlin last week. With Oberlin holding a 1-0 lead, the forward assisted on OWU's first goal, evening the score at one all. She then scored her first collegiate goal - the gamewinner with 2:40 left in regulation. The Bishops have won four straight games after trailing 1-0 in each ... Wooster freshman **Beth Skelton (Arlington, VA/Washington-Lee)** posted two shutouts and played a key role in Wooster's 2-1 upset of previously undefeated Wittenberg last week. Overall, she compiled 15 saves, allowing one goal in the three games, including 14 against the Tigers.

**MEN'S SOCCER REPORT**

Denison (4-0-0, 12 pts. NCAC) can extend its unbeaten streak to five games when the Big Red travel to fourth-place Wabash (2-2-1, 8 pts.) on Saturday. The Big Red are coming off a 1-0 win over Hiram while the Little Giants are rolling after a 3-2 win over Wooster. The week's full slate of games kicks off Tuesday when second-place Kenyon (3-0-1, 10 pts.) hosts Hiram (0-3-1, 1 pt.). The following day, Oberlin (0-4-0, 0 pts.) hosts Allegheny (2-2-0, 5 pts.), Ohio Wesleyan (3-0-0, 9 pts.) hosts Wooster (1-2-0, 3 pts.) and Wittenberg (1-2-0, 3 pts.) hosts Earlham (1-2-1, 4 pts.).

**Notes:** Denison junior goalkeeper **Nick Saper (Evanston, IL/Evanston Township)** made four saves to record his third shutout in the Big Red's last four games with 1-0 win over Hiram ... Kenyon freshman keeper **Colin Blanche (Dublin, Ireland/Grange CC)** started in goal and recorded both of the Lords' shutout wins last week. He had one save against Oberlin and five against Allegheny. Blanche now has three straight shutout wins and has not given up a goal in the last 309 minutes of play ... Wittenberg head coach **Steve Dawson** now has 197 career victories. He entered the season 37th among active Division III coaches in wins. ... The latest NSCAA Great Lakes Regional Coaches Poll ranks Ohio Wesleyan seventh.

**WOMEN'S SOCCER REPORT**

Denison (6-0-0, NCAC), in first place with 17 points, travels to second-place Ohio Wesleyan (4-0-0, 12 pts.) on Thursday to highlight this week's slate of NCAC games. With two weeks remaining before the season-ending conference tournament, this game could go a long way toward determining the top seed in the four-team field. The tournament winner earns the NCAC title as well as the conference's automatic bid into the NCAA Championships. While the matchup on Thursday is the only NCAC contest for the Big Red this week, the Bishops must take the field twice. Ohio Wesleyan will travel to fifth-place Wooster (2-2-0, 6 pts.) on Saturday. The week's schedule kicks off on Tuesday when the Scots travel to fourth-place Wittenberg (2-3-0, 7 pts.). The following day, Hiram (1-3-0, 2 pts.) travels to Kenyon (0-3-1, 1 pt.) and Oberlin (0-3-1, 1 pt.) heads east to third-place Allegheny (3-1-0, 9 pts.). On Saturday, Earlham (1-4-0, 3 pts.) hosts Kenyon, Hiram welcomes Oberlin and Wittenberg entertains Allegheny.

**Notes:** Allegheny goalkeeper **Joan Anderson (Holt, MI/Holt)** posted a pair of shutouts and played 72 minutes of a third in helping the Gators to a 3-0 week, including two NCAC wins. The sophomore did not allow a goal against Earlham (2-0), Penn State-Behrend (5-0) or Kenyon (3-0) and compiled 12 saves for the week ... In the NSCAA/adidas national rankings for Div. III, OWU stands fifth and Denison is 16th. In the Great Lakes Region, the Bishops are first, followed by Denison (3rd), Allegheny (8th) and Wooster (9th).

**VOLLEYBALL REPORT**

Only six squads see action in conference play this week as three NCAC matches are scheduled. On Tuesday, Denison (3-1, 11-10) and Wooster (3-1, 11-7), tied for second place in the standings, face off in Granville. First-place Wittenberg (5-0, 15-4) hosts fourth-place Ohio Wesleyan (3-2, 10-16) and Allegheny (2-2, 10-8) hosts Oberlin (1-4, 1-19) on the following day.

**Notes:** Ohio Wesleyan senior setter **Shana Heilbron (Shaker Heights, OH/Shaker Heights)** averaged 11 assists per game for the Bishops over 11 games last week. She totaled 121 assists, 34 digs, eight kills and three aces as Ohio Wesleyan defeated Earlham and Oberlin and fell to Wooster ... In the AVCA Div. III Coaches poll (Oct. 3), Wittenberg is ranked 12th. In the NCAA III Regional poll, the Tigers are second in the Great Lakes Region.
