NCAC Men's Basketball Report

**WITTENBERG AND WOOSTER CONTINUE TO BATTLE FOR FIRST;
TEAMS JOCKEY FOR POSITION WITH TWO WEEKS LEFT ON SCHEDULE**

February 3, 2002**

CLEVELAND -- Only two weeks of the North Coast schedule remain; Each and every time two teams tipoff, a playoff spot is at stake. The action starts Wednesday, with a full slate of five games. Wabash (8-4, 11-9) tries to solidify its third-place standing when the Little Giants host eighth-place Earlham (3-9, 8-13). The Quakers, on the other hand, are gunning for a tournament berth, and a win Wednesday would help them on their way. The Kenyon Lords (2-10, 41-16), who also have a shot at a spot in the season-ending tourney, travel to fifth-place Oberlin (6-6, 7-13). The Yeomen are aiming for one of the coveted spots in the top four - meaning they would host a quarterfinal contest for the first time since 1992.

Wittenberg (11-1, 18-3) and Wooster (11-1, 17-4) continue their battle for first. The Tigers travel to fourth-place Ohio Wesleyan (7-5, 11-10), while the Scots head east to Allegheny (5-7, 9-10). The Bishops look to rebound after last week's two-game skid - they'd like to hang on to fourth place - while the Gators are fighting to better their tournament prospects. Both teams could prove to be dangerous opponents for the two front-runners. At the opposite end of the standings, Hiram (2-10, 4-17) needs a win to keep tournament play within its grasp. The Terriers travel to Denison (5-7, 5-16). Currently the Big Red are tied for sixth with Allegheny.

Five games are slated for Saturday. Wabash is at Wooster and Denison is at Earlham. Allegheny, Wittenberg and Ohio Wesleyan welcome Kenyon, Hiram and Oberlin, respectively. Scores, stats and standings will be updated on Thursday at www.northcoast.org.

NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S BASKETBALL: Wabash junior **Joe DesJean (Indianapolis, IN/Perry Meridian)** a 6-6 forward, averaged 19.5 points per game, 10 rebounds, and 1.5 blocks in two wins last week. He was 15-of-24 (62.5-percent) from the field and 9-of-11 (81.8-percent) from the free throw line. Against Ohio Wesleyan, he recorded 19 points and 11 rebounds (his ninth double-double of the season). He was 6-of-11 from the field, 7-of-9 from the free throw line, and recorded two blocked shots. In a win over Denison, DesJean compiled 20 points and nine rebounds. He hit 9-of-13 shots from the field, went 2-2 from the free throw line, and had one blocked shot. The two wins elevated Wabash into third place in the NCAC.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL: Denison junior **Michelle Mehling (Grandview Hts., OH/Grandview Hts., OH)**, a 5-7 guard, totalled 37 points, 31 rebounds and seven blocks in three wins last week. She also contributed seven assists and two steals. Against Earlham, Mehling tossed in 15 points; she followed with 10 against Oberlin and 12 against Wooster. She grabbed 17 boards against the Yeowomen. For the week, Mehling averaged 12.3 points per game and 10.3 rebounds. She was 10-11 from the charity stripe. Denison, which has won 11 straight, moved into a first-place tie with Wittenberg courtesy of the three wins.

MEN'S INDOOR TRACK: Ohio Wesleyan junior **Dan Bowens (Montclair, NJ/Montclair)** won the 800 meters at the Ohio Northern Debow Freed Midwest Elite Meet on Feb. 2. His time of 1:56.82 was a personal best and set the Bishop record in the event.

WOMEN'S INDOOR TRACK: Ohio Wesleyan sophomore **Akeya Terrell (Gahanna, OH/Westerville North)** won the 400 meter dash at the Ohio Northern Debow Freed Midwest Elite Meet on Feb. 2. Her time of 59.47 met the NCAA provisional qualifying standard.

MEN'S FIELD EVENTS: Ohio Wesleyan senior **Craig Neeley (Columbus, OH/Bexley)** won the high jump at the Ohio Northern Debow Freed Midwest Elite Meet on Feb. 2. He broke Bishop and ONU Sports Center records with a height of seven feet, 1/4 inches. The height also met the NCAA automatic qualifying standard.

WOMEN'S FIELD EVENTS: Wittenberg sophomore **Kristen Mumper (Cincinnati, OH/Purcell Marian)** claimed second in the triple jump at the Ohio Northern Debow Freed Midwest Elite Meet on Feb. 2, setting a Tiger record (34 feet, three inches). She also placed fifth in the long jump (15' 11 3/4").
