**NCAC Football Report**  
**CONFERENCE SCHEDULE BEGINS**  
**THREE TEAMS BATTLE FOR FIRST**

**For Immediate Release**  
**September 23, 2001**

**CLEVELAND** -- The race for the NCAC championship begins in earnest this week, with five league games slated for Saturday. Three of the contests will feature at least one team striving to hang on to its currently undefeated record, conference or overall. Allegheny, Wittenberg and Wooster, who all share first place in the standings by virtue of a single conference win, look to double their NCAC victory totals. Hiram and Ohio Wesleyan, the conference's only teams with perfect overall records, enter league play hoping to keep the wins rolling in.

For the Tigers (1-0, 3-1) and the Gators (1-0, 1-2) the battle will be especially fierce, as only one team can emerge victorious from their meeting in Springfield on Saturday. Both Allegheny and Wittenberg picked up their conference wins last week. The Gators defeated Denison, 55-21, while the Tigers overcame a stingy Wabash defense to beat the Little Giants, 14-3.

Ohio Wesleyan (0-0, 3-0) and Wooster (1-0, 1-1) also put winning streaks on the line this week in Delaware. The Bishops and Scots, both won last week - Ohio Wesleyan dominated Elmhurst in its final non-conference contest of 2001, 50-16, while Wooster opened their NCAC campaign with a 51-10 win over Kenyon (0-1, 0-2). Hiram (0-0, 2-0) hosts Earlham (0-0, 1-2) Saturday with both teams coming off victories last week. The Terriers, who opened the season 2-0 for the first time since 1994, triumphed, 22-8, over Mt. Saint Joseph. The Quakers beat Manchester, 41-14.

Denison (0-1, 0-3), Kenyon (0-1, 0-2) and Oberlin (0-0, 0-3) will all try to rebound this week and aim for their first league wins of the fall. The Lords travel to Granville to face the Big Red; the Yeomen host Wabash (0-1, 1-2).

**PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

CLEVELAND -- Wooster senior **Chris Cabot (West Lafayette, OH/Ridgewood)** and Allegheny sophomore **David Pisanick (Duncansville, PA/Hollidaysburg)** have been named offensive and defensive "Players of the Week" for their performances last week in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

**Cabot**, a 5-11, 185-pound wide receiver, hauled in seven passes for a Scot-record 200 yards and scored two touchdowns in leading the Wooster past Kenyon, 51-10. The previous Scot record was held by **Brandon Good**, who amassed 195 receiving yards against Allegheny in 1995.

**Pisanick**, a 6-2, 205-pound linebacker, led a Gator defense which held Denison to -15 yards rushing and tied a school record with nine sacks. Pisanick totaled three sacks, two solo stops, two assists and four tackles for a loss in the 55-21 defeat of the Big Red.

**GRID NOTEBOOK:** Earlham senior **Will Hughes (Indianapolis, IN/Lawrence North)** caught five passes for 170 yards and three touchdowns against Manchester. His three scores tie the Quaker single-game record. He holds Earlham's career record for receiving touchdowns with 15 ... Hiram senior quarterback **Dwayne Pavkovich (Poland, OH/Seminary)** completed 19 of 32 passes for 239 yards and two touchdowns as the Terriers overcame an eight-point start by Mt. Saint Joseph. Pavkovich also ran in a touchdown ... Kenyon senior **Andy Mills (Columbus, OH/Upper Arlington)** returned eight kickoffs for 199 yards. The defensive back is now fourth on the Lords all-time list with 46 returns for 1,069 yards ... Oberlin junior wide receiver **Rick Valenzuela (Manteca, CA/Modesto Junior College)** caught 12 passes for a season-high 203 yards against Case Western Reserve ... Three Ohio Wesleyan players rushed for more than 100 yards against Elmhurst, something that has not happened for the Bishops since 1993. Senior tailback **Matt Capone (Cleveland, OH/Padua)** and sophomore halfback **Chad Smith (Prospect, IL/Elgin)** each gained 175 yards on the ground. Smith added two touchdowns, while Capone scored the go-ahead TD in the second quarter. Freshman halfback **Eric Indiciani (Delaware, OH/Olentangy)** contributed an additional 119 yards rushing. Ohio Wesleyan broke two NCAC records and three school marks in the win. The Bishops' new league (and school) records: 561 rushing yards, 37 first downs. New school record: 727 yards of total offense ... The Wabash defense held Wittenberg to 230 yards of total offense last week. Junior linebacker **Nate Boulais (Indianapolis, IN/Ben Davis)** paced the effort with eight tackles, one and one-half tackles for losses and a half sack ... Wittenberg senior wide receiver **Michael Aljancic (Louisville, OH/Louisville)** caught seven passes for 97 yards and a touchdown, his third in four games.

**NORTH COAST CONFERENCE SCHEDULES IN FULL SWING;  
WITTENBERG OWNS ONLY UNBEATEN RECORD IN FIELD HOCKEY**

**CLEVELAND** -- Following is a capsule roundup of the NCAC's fall sports action.

**CROSS COUNTRY REPORT**

Three North Coast schools will be in action this week, one on Friday, two on Saturday. Wooster starts things off at the Walsh Invitational on Friday. The next day, Earlham enjoys home course advantage at their own Invitational while Wittenberg travels to the Loyola Lakefront Invitational. All other squads are idle until the weekend of October 5-6. Allegheny will compete in the Paul Short Invitational at Lehigh on Saturday, the 6th, while Denison, Hiram, Kenyon and Oberlin will join Ohio Wesleyan for the All-Ohio Championships in Delaware.

The Wabash cross country team won the first Wabash Invitational on Sept. 21, finishing with 26 points. **Dan Ruge (Chesteron, IN/Chesteron)** and **Jared Smit (Lafayette, IN/Central Catholic)** crossed the line almost simultaneously to take second and third place, respectively, with a time of 26:51. Wabash also competed at the Indiana Intercollegiate Championships held Sept. 17 at Purdue. The team took fourth place in the Little State Division of the meet and was eighth out of 17 teams overall.

The Kenyon men, ranked 15th in Division III, won the 12-team Cedarville Friendship Invitational with 44 points. Junior **Ben Hildebrand (Fairport, NY/The Harley School)** won the race with a time of 25:45.99. Freshman **Matt Cabrera (Longmont, CO/Skyview, WA)** placed third with a time of 26:04.99. The Kenyon women placed eighth in 12-team field (175 points). The event was won by the hosts (33 points). The Ladies' top runner, junior **Megan Biddle (Reynoldsburg, OH/North Central, IN)** placed 16th (19:31.31). Also, in the women's race, the top Division III team finish belonged to Wittenberg in seventh. Junior **Abi Gerstle (Kettering, OH/Fairmont)** paced the Tigers with an eighth-place finish (9:18.26). She was followed across the finish line by teammate **Sara Weide (Fort Wayne, IN/Homestead)** in ninth (9:19.63). The Ohio Wesleyan men and women both finished fifth at the Otterbein Invitational. The Wooster men finished fourth at their own Invitational, Hiram finished eighth. The Wooster women earned a seventh-place finish.

**MEN'S CROSS COUNTRY:** Wooster junior **Brendan Callahan (South Glastonbury, CT/Glastonbury)** was the fastest Scot runner at the Wooster Invitational. He covered the five-mile course in 27:15, good enough for fourth.

**WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY:** Wittenberg junior **Abi Gerstle (Kettering, OH/Fairmont)** paced the Tigers with a time of 9:18.26 at the Cedarville Friendship Invitational. She finished eighth out of 151 runners.

**FIELD HOCKEY:** Wooster senior **Emily White (Princeton, WV/Western Reserve Academy, OH)** scored two goals and added two assists as the Scots won twice in conference play. White scored once in the second half of a 3-0 victory over Kenyon, then exploded for a goal and two assists in the second half of a 3-1 defeat of Denison. She ranks third in the NCAC with 1.60 points per game.

**MEN'S SOCCER:** Wittenberg sophomore forward **Taggart Suddes (Ostrander, OH/Dublin Coffman)** netted both goals in the Tigers' 2-1 overtime win against Baldwin-Wallace. Three days later, against Muskingum, he added a hat trick as Wittenberg rolled, 7-1. He leads the NCAC with 2.11 points per game.

**WOMEN'S SOCCER:** Denison senior forward **Dana Grandmaison (Duluth, MN/Marshall School)** tallied the gamewinning goal in overtime to propel the Big Red past Kenyon, 2-1. She added another goal to her week's output, scoring the second goal in a 3-2 win over Allegheny.

**VOLLEYBALL:** Allegheny sophomore setter **Vicki Kajder (Trafford, PA/Penn-Trafford)** led the Gators to a 2-1 week, including a 2-0 mark in NCAC play, with 127 assists (10.58 per game) and 53 digs (4.43 per game). In Allegheny's five-game victory over Ohio Wesleyan, she recorded 62 assists.

**FIELD HOCKEY REPORT**

NCAC leader Wittenberg (2-0, 9-3) is the lone undefeated squad in conference play and the Tigers put that mark on the line twice this week. Denison (2-1, 2-5) travels to Springfield on Monday and the next day Kenyon (0-2, 0-4) makes the trip. Second-place Wooster (3-1, 5-1) visits Earlham (1-1, 2-3) on Saturday for the Scots' only conference action this week. The Quakers, coming off a 3-1 defeat of Ohio Wesleyan (1-4, 3-6), look to stay in the win column with a road contest at Denison on Tuesday. Also on Tuesday, the Bishops play host to Oberlin (1-2, 2-2). The Yeowomen return home on Saturday to take on Kenyon.

**Notes:** NCAC goalkeepers dominated the nets last week. Kenyon's **Tamar Chalker (Meriden, NH/Deerfield)** made a combined 34 saves in two losses last week and had a save percentage of .872. Earlham senior **Shannon Shehan (Centerville, IN/Centerville)** averaged 14 saves in the Quakers' 1-1 week, including 17 in the victory over OWU. Wittenberg senior **Georgina Klinzing (Gasport, NY/Royalton-Hartland)** earned her fourth shutout in five games this season in a 1-0 defeat of Oberlin. She has an NCAC-leading .931 saves percentage on the year. Wooster senior **Emily White (Princeton, WV/Western Reserve Academy, OH)** scored two goals and added two assists as the Scots won twice in conference play. Senior midfielder **Kim Dubovec (Chagrin Falls, OH/Kenston)** of Ohio Wesleyan scored her first collegiate goal in the Bishop win over Kenyon.

**MEN'S SOCCER REPORT**

Eight conference games fill this week's schedule as three teams have grabbed an early grip on first place. Denison (1-0-0, 4-3-0), Ohio Wesleyan (1-0-0, 4-5-0) and Wooster (1-0-0, 6-1-0) all share the top spot in the standings after the opening week of the conference schedule. Things kick off on Tuesday as the Big Red host Oberlin (0-0-0, 1-4-0). On Saturday, Wabash packs its bags for Allegheny and Earlham heads to Hiram while Denison, Ohio Wesleyan and Wittenberg travel to Wooster, Oberlin and Kenyon, respectively. Two games postponed two weeks ago, have been rescheduled. Earlham travels to Allegheny on Sunday and Wabash will play at Hiram the same day.

**Notes:** Earlham junior forward **Marc Sampson (Centerville, OH/Centerville)** recorded a goal and an assist in two Quaker wins last week ... Ohio Wesleyan senior back **Philip Hoffman (Kettering, OH/Alter)** tallied two goals and an assist for the Bishops last week.
