**NCAC Football Report**

**NORTH COAST CONFERENCE ACTION KICKS OFF;  
NCAC TEAMS FIND SUCCESS OUTSIDE CONFERENCE**

September 9, 2001**

**CLEVELAND** -- This week provides a taste test of the 2001 North Coast Conference season as the schedule features the first two league games of the fall. The Hiram Terriers (0-0, 1-0), fresh off their season-opening 30-17 win over Bluffton, travel to Gambier to face the Kenyon Lords (0-0, 0-1). The second game pits the visiting Oberlin Yeomen (0-0, 0-2) against the Earlham Quakers (0-0, 0-2). Both the Quakers and the Yeomen are looking to pick up their first win of the season. Last week, Pomona-Pitzer narrowly slipped past Oberlin after scoring on a 43-yard punt return with only 1:59 left in the game. The Yeomen held a 21-13 lead in the fourth quarter. Earlham fell to Centre, 38-7.

This week's schedule also features three teams trying to continue their winning ways against non-conference competition. Wittenberg (0-0, 2-0), NCAA Division III's all-time winningest program, visits Alma on Saturday. The Tigers defeated Heidelberg, 59-7 last week. Ohio Wesleyan (0-0, 1-0) and Wabash (0-0, 1-0) also tallied checks in the win column last week. The Bishops, who beat Olivet, 34-16, take to the road to face Waynesburg while the Little Giants stay home to take on Wheaton, after downing Manchester, 45-21 last week.

The Wooster Fighting Scots (0-0, 0-1), coming off a 39-37 loss to Kalamazoo, head to Grove City. Allegheny (0-0, 0-2) must contend with its third straight road game of the young season when the Gators match up against Frostburg State. Denison (0-0, 0-1), returning to action after a bye week, hosts Randolph-Macon in the Big Red's home opener to round out this week's schedule.

**PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

**CLEVELAND** -- Hiram senior **Dwayne Pavkovich (Poland, OH/Seminary)** and Wabash sophomore **Stu Johnson (West Lafayette, IN/Jefferson)** have been named offensive and defensive "Players of the Week" for their performances last week in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

**Pavkovich**, a 6-1, 190-pound quarterback, totaled four touchdowns, elevating the Terriers to their first win under new head coach **Mike Meyer**. Pavkovich was 10-for-22 for 94 yards passing and two touchdowns. He rushed for an additional 84 yards and two TDs on 14 carries.

**Johnson**, a 6-1, 190-pound defensive back, paced the Little Giants with 11.5 stops, including 10 solos, in Wabash's 45-21 defeat of Manchester - the first win for new head coach **Chris Creighton**. Johnson also came up with an interception in his first career start.

**GRID NOTEBOOK:** Allegheny senior tailback **Shane Ream (Meadville, PA/Meadville)** became the Gators' all-time leading rusher after piling up 133 yards against Washington & Jefferson. His career total momentarily sits at 3,327 ... Oberlin sophomore defensive back **Mark Lengel (Livonia, MI/Orchard Lake St. Mary's)** recorded 12 tackles, one forced fumble, a fumble recovery and one pass break up in the Yeomen's 25-21 loss to Pomona Pitzer. Senior linebacker **Sam Hobi (Ephraim, UT/Snow College)** also tallied 12 tackles, including seven solos and one sack ... Ohio Wesleyan senior tailback **Matt Capone (Cleveland, OH/Padua)** scored three touchdowns, propelling the Bishops to a 34-0 halftime lead and a 34-16 win over visiting Olivet ... Wabash junior quarterback **Jake Knott (Lafayette, IN/Jefferson)** opened the 2001 season with five touchdowns, throwing for three and running for two. He tied sophomore running back **David Sutherland (Champaign, IL/Centennial)** with a game-high 53 rushing yards. Knott finished the game with 238 yards in the air (21-for-33) ... Wittenberg senior defensive end **Tim Daoust (Toledo, Ohio/Central Catholic)** recorded three quarterback sacks in limited action against Heidelberg. He has four on the season, and stands just three away from the Tigers' career sacks record ... Wooster senior wide receiver **Darryl Simmons (Reading, PA/Marietta, OH)** had career-highs in both receptions (nine) and receiving yards (175) in the Scots 39-37 loss to Kalamazoo. His 175 yards are the fourth-most for a single game in Wooster history. He also scored two touchdowns.

**NCAC Fall Sports Update**

**MEN'S AND WOMEN'S SOCCER , VOLLEYBALL BEGIN NCAC PLAY;  
KENYON MEN'S CROSS COUNTRY WINS GLCA CHAMPIONSHIP**

**CLEVELAND** -- Following is a capsule roundup of the NCAC's fall sports action.

**CROSS COUNTRY REPORT**

Only three North Coast schools will set up at the starting line this week. Earlham competes at the Indiana Intercollegiate in West Lafayette on Friday. Allegheny will travel to Penn State's Spike Shoe Invitational and Ohio Wesleyan will race neighboring Wilmington, both on Saturday. All NCAC squads will be back in action in two weeks, Sept. 21-22, with the exception of Earlham.

Six of ten NCAC schools raced in the Great Lakes Colleges Association meet at Earlham last week. Kenyon, ranked 12th nationally, captured the men's title with a total of 41 points. Wabash's 89 points placed them fourth. Wooster (121) finished fifth, followed by Denison (181), Ohio Wesleyan (209) and Earlham (228) who finished seventh, eighth and ninth, respectively. Kenyon led all NCAC teams in the women's competition, placing second behind winner DePauw, with 53 points. Denison earned 87 points for a third-place finish, followed by Wooster (99) in fourth, Earlham (100) in fifth and Ohio Wesleyan (148) in seventh. Kenyon junior **Ben Hildebrand (Fairport, NY/The Harley School)** paced the Lords with a second-place finish (27:09). Earlham senior **Beth Smith (East Berlin, PA/Hershey)** was the NCAC's top female finisher. Her time of 20:31 placed her third in the overall individual standings.

The Allegheny women won their own Classic last week with 19 points. Allegheny junior **Nicole Morandi (Tewksbury, MA/Tewksbury)** posted a time of 19:19 to place first overall. Oberlin (86) finished third. In the men's race, Allegheny took second place (74), while Oberlin (121) finished fifth and Hiram (253) finished ninth.

**WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY:** Earlham senior **Beth Smith (East Berlin, PA/Hershey)** was the NCAC's top female finisher at last week's Great Lakes Colleges Association Championship. Her time of 20:31 placed her third in the overall individual standings.

**FIELD HOCKEY:** Earlham sophomore midfielder **Rebecca Aldred (Glen Mills, PA/West Nottingham Academy)** had a hand in all five Quaker goals last week. In a 3-0 victory over Hanover, she notched her first career hat trick in accounting for all three scores. In a loss to Oberlin, she assisted on both Earlham goals.

**MEN'S SOCCER:** Kenyon freshman **Duma Magagula (Bulawayo, Zimbabwe)** scored game-winning goals in both Lord victories last week. He notched the first goal in a 2-0 defeat of Marietta and the lone score in a 1-0 victory over Heidelberg. Magagula is the team's scoring leader with six points through five games.

**WOMEN'S SOCCER:** Oberlin senior forward/midfielder **Becky Kanuch (Oberlin, OH/Oberlin)** led the Yeowomen with four goals and four assists for 12 points in victories over Lake Erie and Bluffton last week. She leads the NCAC in scoring with six goals and 16 points (4.00 points per game) in four games this season.

**VOLLEYBALL:** Earlham junior hitter **Teresa Batteiger (Bargersville, IN/Indianapolis Lutheran)** led the Quakers with 85 digs (4.25 per game), including 31 in one game against Heidelberg, and 30 kills (1.50 per game) as the team placed fifth at the Crusader Invitational. She is the team's leader with 3.78 digs per game this season and ranks fifth in the NCAC in that category.

**FIELD HOCKEY REPORT**

Defending North Coast co-champion Wittenberg (2-0, 3-0) has started the 2001 season on a perfect note, winning both of its early conference games. This week the Tigers look for wins number three and four in their quest for a solo league title, as they host Denison (0-0, 0-1) on Wednesday and Oberlin (1-0, 2-0) on Saturday. Denison will open their '01 campaign on Monday, when it hosts Ohio Wesleyan (0-1, 1-3). In other conference action this week, Earlham (0-1, 1-1) travels to Kenyon Saturday and to Wooster on Sunday. Kenyon will also play host to Oberlin this week, welcoming the Yeowomen on Wednesday. Wooster also hosts Ohio Wesleyan on Wednesday and travels to Oberlin on Saturday.

**Notes:** Oberlin has a pair of scoring sisters to thank for its quick start. Senior midfielder **Emily Johnson (Columbus, OH/Laurel)** scored two goals in the Yeowomen's win 6-2 win over Earlham. So did Emily's sister, freshman midfielder/forward **Jaime** ... Ohio Wesleyan senior forward **Kristin Beveridge (Hudson, OH/Hudson)** scored the gamewinner in the Bishops first win of the season, a 1-0 defeat of Transylvania ... Wittenberg's hot start has been helped by the sizzling start of freshman **Ciaran Kislring (Washington, NJ/Warren Hills)** who has scored a goal in each of her three collegiate games, including the gamewinner in a 1-0 win over DePauw.

**MEN'S SOCCER REPORT**

The 2001 North Coast season kicks off with two games this week. First up is Earlham (0-0-0, 1-2-1) at Allegheny (3-2-0), followed by Wabash (0-0-0, 2-1-0) at Hiram (0-0-0, 0-2-0), both on Saturday.

The Wooster Fighting Scots (0-0-0, 4-0-0) are off to a blazing beginning - they're the only undefeated team in the NCAC. After defeating Marietta, 3-1, Baldwin-Wallace, 1-0, and Mt. Union, 3-1, last week the Scots have run their win streak up to four. Wooster has equaled its victory total from the same point last season. They look to extend their current string when they host Capital on Tuesday and Olivet on Saturday. Last season's champion, Ohio Wesleyan (0-0-0, 3-2-0) is off to a slower start than usual, with three wins in five games. Last week, the Bishops, ranked third in the Great Lakes Region and 25th nationally by the NSCAA, defeated Capital 4-0, then beat Alma, 4-1, before falling to New Jersey, 2-1. Up next for the Bishops: Wilmington, ranked fourth in the Great Lakes Region, on Wednesday, followed by DePauw, ranked ninth regionally, on Saturday.

**WOMEN'S SOCCER REPORT**

The first match of the 2001 conference campaign will take place on Saturday when Earlham (0-0-0, 1-2-1) travels to Allegheny (0-0-0, 3-1-0).

Hiram (0-0-0, 3-0-0) is off to a strong start, in part due to the efforts of freshman **Liz Clifford (Solon, OH/Orange)**. She scored the game-winning goal in overtime in a 1-0 decision over Huntington to lift the Terriers to a 3-0 mark on the year. Clifford has five goals in her first three collegiate games. Oberlin (0-0-0, 2-2-0) had a solid week as well with two shutout victories. Junior **Courtney Stackhouse (Woodbridge, VA/Bishop Ireton)** and senior **Becky Kanuch (Oberlin, OH/Oberlin)** combined for nine of 13 Yeowomen scores and 23 points last week. Ohio Wesleyan (0-0-0, 3-1-0) sophomore goalkeeper **Tiffany Soggs (North Royalton, OH/North Royalton)** recorded four saves as the Bishops notched two shutout victories last week. Wooster (0-0-0, 3-1-0) senior **Stephanie Hulke (Basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge)** totaled 12 points last week as the Scots took two of three games. She recorded a hat trick in Wooster's 4-2 triumph over Wilmington.

**Polls:** In the NSCAA/adidas NCAA Division III women's poll (Sept. 3), Ohio Wesleyan is ranked 10th and Denison is 24th. Allegheny also received votes. In the Sept. 3rd NSCAA/adidas Great Lakes regional poll, the Bishops are the top ranked team, Denison is third, Allegheny fourth and Wittenberg ninth.

**VOLLEYBALL REPORT**

The conference schedule gets under way this week with two NCAC matches on tap. Tuesday, Kenyon (0-0, 0-5) will travel to Wooster (0-0, 8-3) and Wednesday, four-time defending champion Wittenberg (0-0, 6-2) visits Earlham (0-0, 2-8).

Wittenberg has reached the championship match in both tournaments they've participated in thus far. Last week, the Tigers were runners-up at the Elmhurst Tourney. Sophomore middle hitter **Sarah Muzi (Canton, OH/GlenOak)** earned all-tournament honors for the second time this season. Wooster also finished second in a tournament last weekend when they took four of five matches at the Carnegie Mellon Invitational. Freshman setter/defensive specialist **Becky Rohlfs (Cincinnati, OH/Mount Notre Dame)** was named all-tournament for second consecutive week. Earlham placed fifth in Capital University's Crusader Invitational, while Oberlin (0-0, 0-10) was seventh at the same event. Quaker freshman setter **Brandy Bennett (Danville, IN/Danville Community)** had 164 assists (8.2 per game) and 47 digs (2.35) in the tournament. Ohio Wesleyan (0-0, 3-6) senior middle hitter **Adrienne Knox (Beavercreek, OH/Beavercreek)** set a school record with 10 services aces against Centre in last weekend's Hanover Invitational. Kenyon junior **Cori Arnold (West Lafayette, OH/Ridgewood)** led the Ladies at the Baldwin-Wallace tournament. Ranked fifth in the NCAC in kills and second in blocks, she had 53 kills, 35 digs and 19 blocks in 18 games.
