**NCAC Men's Basketball Report**

**WOOSTER, WITTENBERG AND OHIO WESLEYAN SPLIT FIRST;  
TIGERS AND BISHOPS MEET WEDNESDAY**

**January 12, 2003**

**CLEVELAND** -- Entering the week, three teams are perched atop the North Coast standings. Wooster (4-0, 12-1), Wittenberg (4-0, 9-3) and Ohio Wesleyan (4-0, 8-5) have each swept their first four conference contests. The standings should see a shake-up by week's end as all 10 NCAC teams must play twice this week. The Tigers and Battling Bishops start off the schedule when they meet in Delaware on Wednesday. Wittenberg topped Ohio Wesleyan three times last season, twice during the regular season and once in the NCAC Tournament. The Fighting Scots host fifth-place Allegheny (2-2, 6-7) on Wednesday. Wooster took all three meetings with the Gators last winter. Earlham (2-2, 7-6), tied with Allegheny for fifth place, travels to instate rival, Wabash (3-1, 9-3). The Little Giants slid into fourth place after a 76-63 loss to Wooster last week. Earlham and Wabash split a pair of games in 2002-03, with each team winning on the road. The final two midweek games send Hiram (1-3, 3-10) and Kenyon (0-4, 0-12) to Denison (0-4, 2-10) and Oberlin (0-4-0-11), respectively. Last winter the Terriers and Big Red played twice, with each team winning on the others home court. Kenyon beat Oberlin twice. All 10 NCAC teams will also take the court on Saturday with five league contests scheduled. **CATANZARITE, HALICKI NAMED NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

**CLEVELAND** -- Allegheny's **Nick Catanzarite (Strongsville, OH/Walsh Jesuit)** and Kenyon's **Dana Halicki (North Royalton, OH/Padua Franciscan)** have been named men's and women's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

**Catanzarite**, a 6-1, senior guard, averaged 19.3 points and 6.0 rebounds as the Gators went 2-1 overall and 1-0 in NCAC play last week. He shot 53.8 percent (21-39), averaged 3.3 assists, and 4.0 steals. Catanzarite capped off the week by scoring 22 points in a 83-68 win against Kenyon, including 20 points over the last five minutes of the first half, and added eight rebounds. In a loss to Penn St.-Behrend, he had 20 points and two boards. Catanzarite started the week with 16 points in an 88-69 drubbing of non-conference opponent Alfred.

**Halicki**, a 5-8, sophomore guard, tossed in a combined 26 points, including tying a career-best 18 points against Denison. She hit a pair of three-pointers and was 8-of-9 at the free throw line in the Ladies' two games. Halicki also had 13 rebounds and six steals.

The Big Red won the 400 medley and 400 freestyle relays as well. For the women, **Sarah Peck (Palo Alto, CA/Henry M. Gunn Senior)**, **Lauren Clark (Coravallis, OR/Crescent Valley)** and **Nikki Weaver (Dayton, OH/Bellbrook)** were won the 100 free, 200 breast and the diving events, respectively ... Hiram's men's team won two dual meets to go 7-0 on the season, its best start in school history. Senior **Mario Halbert (Cleveland, OH/John Hay)** won both diving events, junior **Jason Groselle (Hiram, OH/Crestwood)** won the 50 free (25.51) and 100 free (57.67), and sophomore **Zach Huggins (Ashtabula, OH/Sts. Leading the Ladies were **Rachel Smith (Charles City, IA/Charles City)** and **Laura Wareck (Lancaster, MA/Gardner)**, who won the 1000 free (10:33.59) and 200 breast (2:34.46), respectively. Kenyon lost 142-90 in the women's meet ... Ohio Wesleyan swept dual meet with Findlay over the weekend.
