**WITTENBERG BEGINS NORTH COAST TITLE DEFENSE SATURDAY:
WOOSTER OPENS 2002-03 SEASON WITH WIN**

CLEVELAND -- North Coast Athletic Conference champion Wittenberg (0-0, 3-2) opens its title defense against Allegheny (0-0, 2-3) at home on Saturday to highlight this week's schedule. The Tigers defeated the Gators twice during the 2001-02 regular season on their way to their seventh NCAC title.

Wooster, the only team to have already played a conference contest, sits atop the standings after defeating Denison, 74-63, on Wednesday. However, the Fighting Scots may not be alone for long as all 10 North Coast teams will take to the court on Saturday and Sunday. In addition to the Allegheny-Wittenberg matchup on Saturday, Earlham (0-0, 3-3) travels to Oberlin (0-0, 0-5) and Ohio Wesleyan (0-0, 2-1) heads to Hiram (0-0, 2-3), while the Scots visit Kenyon (0-0, 0-5). Denison (0-1, 2-4) drives west to Wabash (0-0, 4-2) on Sunday. The game, originally set for Saturday, was moved to Sunday to allow for support of the Little Giants football team. Wabash faces Mt. Union in a NCAA Division III Quarterfinal.

NELSON, HEIL NAMED NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CLEVELAND -- Wooster's **Bryan Nelson (Kettering, OH/Kettering Fairmont)** and Ohio Wesleyan's **Kelly Heil (Sylvania, OH/Southview)** have been named men's and women's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

Nelson, a 6-4, senior forward, had a team-high 13 points and eight rebounds in a 64-53 win over Westminster, and then carried the Scots to a hard-fought 74-63 win over Denison in the NCAC opener. Against the Big Red, Nelson finished with game-highs in points (24) and rebounds (10), as well as team-highs in assists (5) and blocked shots (2). Overall he totaled 37 points on 14-of-25 field-goal shooting and 8-of-9 free throw shooting and grabbed 18 boards.

Heil, a 5-10, sophomore wing, drilled a three-pointer to put the Bishops ahead to stay and finished with team bests of 19 points and six rebounds in a 70-68 win at Ohio Northern. Heil then scored eight points during an early 14-0 run, including a three-pointer to put the Bishops ahead to stay, in Ohio Wesleyan's conference opener at Oberlin. She led the Bishops with 21 points.

SWIM SCENE: All of the conference swimming and diving squads were idle for the holiday weekend and everyone but Hiram will return to action this weekend. Allegheny travels to compete in the Eastern Michigan Invitational, today through Saturday. Denison is the only NCAA Division III squad invited to participate in the University of Notre Dame Invitational the same days. Kenyon and Oberlin are in Oxford, Ohio, to participate in the Miami Invitational, while Wabash and Wittenberg swim at the DePauw Invitational this weekend. Wooster will compete in the University of Akron's Zippy Invitational, which draws teams from Division I and national powers out of divisions II and III. The Zippy Invitational was the second-largest swim invitational of its kind last season, not including NCAA Championships, and brought some outstanding performances out of Scot swimmers last year. Ohio Wesleyan is the only team slated for a dual meet, when they visit John Carroll on Saturday.

Wooster's **Kayla Heising (Wauseonm, OH/Wauseion)** has the fastest time in Division III in the 50-yard freestyle (23.74) so far this season. The Scots 200 medley relay combination of **Jenny Bayuk (Beaver Falls, PA/Blackhawk)**, Heising, **Tanya Tarasenkov (Coraopolis, PA/Montour)**, and **Liz Whittam (Okemos, MI/State College Area)** has the division's second-best time (1:50.05). Heising, Tanya Tarasenkov and her sister **Sonya Tarasenkov (Coraopolis, PA/Montour)**, with **Kate Henley (Wooster, OH/Wooster)** combined in the 200 free relay to record a 1:39.46 clocking, also second-best in the nation ... Hiram freshman **Beth Groselle (Hiram, OH/Crestwood)** has set school records in five individual events in just two collegiate meets, and has met the NCAA "B" cuts in three of them ... The Terrier men have equaled their best start to a season (5-0), that was set last season.
