**FIVE TEAMS SHARE FIRST PLACE AFTER EARLY GAMES;  
NCAC TEAMS IN NON-CONFERENCE ACTION UNTIL JAN. 5**

**CLEVELAND** -- Eight of 10 North Coast squads take the court this week, all in non-conference action. Play tips off on Tuesday when and Kenyon (0-1,0-6) travels to Bethany. On Wednesday, two NCAC teams hit the road. Earlham (1-0, 4-3) travels to Rose-Hulman, while Wittenberg (1-0, 4-2) faces off against Otterbein. Allegheny (0-1,2-4) is at Capital on Thursday, while Ohio Wesleyan (1-0,3-1) hosts Ohio Dominican. On Friday, Hiram (0-1,2-4) welcomes Notre Dame (OH), while the two-day Pete Thorn Invitational tips off at Wabash (1-0, 5-2). Ohio Wesleyan and Denison (0-2,2-5) close out the week on Saturday. The Bishops head to Eastern Kentucky, while the Big Red stay home to face Grove City. Wooster (2-0, 6-0) is idle until Friday, Dec. 20. Oberlin (0-1, 0-6) is off until Saturday, Dec. 28.

Conference action does not resume until Friday, Jan. 3. Currently, five squads, Wooster, Ohio Wesleyan, Wabash, Wittenberg and Earlham, share first place in the early going. **SCHWAB, RICE NAMED NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

**CLEVELAND** -- Ohio Wesleyan's **Travis Schwab (Medina, OH/Medina)** and Wooster's **Kristen Rice (Wooster, OH/Northwestern)** have been named men's and women's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

**Schwab**, a 6-6, junior center, scored his 1000th career point in Saturday's 76-64 North Coast Athletic Conference win at Hiram. Schwab's milestone came on a lay-in with 6:15 left in the first half. The basket broke a 17-17 tie and put Ohio Wesleyan ahead to stay. Schwab finished with 19 points and 12 rebounds. He was a perfect 4-for-4 from the free-throw line and shot 7-for-12 (.583) from the floor.

**Rice**, a 6-0, senior center, scored a career-high 24 points on seven field goals (7-for-15, .467) and 10-of-12 (.833) shooting from the foul line, and matched a career-high rebound total (13) in the 76-60 win over Allegheny. It marked the fourth double-double of her career.
