### **NCAC Men's Basketball Report**

**WOOSTER BEGINS TITLE DEFENSE WEDNESDAY;  
CONFERENCE SCHEDULE BEGINS THIS WEEK**

November 28, 2005**

**CLEVELAND** -- Denison (2-2) hosts defending champion Wooster (4-0) on Wednesday to open the 2005 North Coast schedule. This is the only time the squads will meet this season. The Scots won the only meeting between the schools during the 2004-05 regular season, 90-60. All ten schools see conference action on Saturday. Scheduled for that day are Denison at Wittenberg (4-0), Kenyon (2-2) at Allegheny (2-2), Oberlin (0-5) at Wabash (2-3), Ohio Wesleyan (3-2) at Hiram (0-0) and the Scots at Earlham (2-1).

Wittenberg was tabbed as the preseason favorite in voting by coaches and media earlier this fall. Wooster was second in both polls, followed by Wabash in third, Denison in fourth and Ohio Wesleyan in fifth.

**Notes:** **ALLEGHENY** junior **Casey McCloskey (Erie, PA/Cathedral Prep)** averaged 22 points and five assists during the Gators' National City holiday Tournament. The team fell to Baldwin-Wallace in the semis as McCloskey scored 26 on 9-for-11 shooting, then was Allegheny's high scorer with 18 in a consolation final loss to Juniata. Freshman **Ryan Hollihan (Saxenbert, PA/Knoch)** contributed 13 points, nine rebounds and four blocked shots in the loss to the Eagles ... **DENISON** defeated Muskingum on a last-second shot by junior guard **Tony Julian (Dublin, OH/Coffman)**, then lost to Marietta in the OAC vs. NCAC Challenge. Junior **Dan Hodgkinson (Lake Forest, IL/Lake Forest)** led the Big Red against the Muskies with 22 points, then scored the 1000th point of his career in the loss to the Crusaders. Hodgkinson, the 15th player in Denison men's basketball history to reach that milestone, enters the week with 1,008 career points. Senior **Robb Hern (Madeira, OH/Madiera)** scored 22 and pulled down 14 rebounds against Muskingum, then led his team with another 22 and 18 boards against Capital. Through four games, Hern is averaging 19.3 points and 12.3 rebounds per game ... **EARLHAM** lost for the first time this season, 72-62 to Bluffton, despite 18 points and nine rebounds from junior **Markous Jewett (Richmond, IN/Richmond)** ... **KENYON** also went 1-1 in the OAC vs. NCAC Challenge. The Lords defeated Marietta then lost to Muskingum. Freshman guard **Korey Haddox (Zanesville, OH/Zanesville)** shot 16-for-21 (76.2) in the two games to total 40 points. He sank 31 points against the Pioneers, with six rebounds and was 7-for-8 at the free-throw line ... **OBERLIN** lost three times last week. Junior **Quinton Spencer (Chicago, IL/Brother Rice)** had a double-double with 25 points and 11 rebounds in a 96-80 loss to Baldwin-Wallace. Sophomore **Matthew Godwin (Chicago, IL/St. Rita)** added 19 points on 5-for-7 shooting from three-point range. Godwin then led the Yeomen with a game-high 24 points in a 106-70 loss to Carnegie Mellon. In his team's last four games, he has racked up 61 points and was 15-for-31 (48.5) from behind the arc ... In a 2-1 week, **OHIO WESLEYAN** defeated Washington & Jefferson, 70-67, as junior guard **Matt Shirer (Medina, OH/Medina)** broke a 67-67 tie with a three pointer in the closing seconds. Junior post **Ben Chojnacki (Medina, OH/Medina)** led the Bishops with 16 points and four assists in that game, then shot 8-for-8 from the field for a team-best 19 points in a 76-68 defeat of Mount Union in the Hanover tournament. In the championship game of the Hanover tourney, Chojnacki added another 18 points and was named to the all-tournament team ... At the Colorado College/Clarion Hotels Thanksgiving Invitational, **WABASH** lost to Bethany of Kansas, 70-63, then defeated Philadelphia Bible, 77-35. The Little Giants also lost to Hanover last week, 62-59. Senior guard **Adonis Joseph (Mishawaka, IN/Mishawaka)** totaled 30 points in the three games to lead his team in scoring. Sophomore center **Gary Simkus (Highland, IN/Highland)** and senior guard **Michael Woods (Indianapolis, IN/Cathedral)** earned all-tournament honors in Colorado. The 35 points allowed against Philadelphia Bible were the fewest allowed by a Wabash team since the 1947-48 Little Giants allowed 31 in a defeat of Butler ... **WITTENBERG** is off to a strong start with four wins over previously unbeaten teams. The 10th ranked Tigers defeated Capital, 73-54, and Transylvania, 63-51. Senior **Daniel Russ (Louisville, KY/Trinity)** posted a game-high 12 points and eight rebounds against Transy, while senior wing **Phil Steffes (Centerville, OH/Centerville)** scored 15 in the first half against the Crusaders, one short of his career best ... Like the Tigers, **WOOSTER** is undefeated through four games. The Scots won last weekend's Emory & Henry Invitational with victories over Methodist (77-63) and the hosts (150-101). Junior forward **Tim Vandervaart (North Canton, OH/Hoover)** earned tournament MVP honors after scoring 36 points (12-for-19), including 12-for-17 from the free-throw line and pulled down 33 rebounds in the two games, posting double-doubles in both games. The 150 points scored by the Scots against Emory & Henry were the most scored by a Wooster team in school history. The Scots also set school marks with field goals made (63) and first-half points (80).

**NCAC TEAMS OPEN 2005-06 BASKETBALL SCHEDULES;  
CONFERENCE SCHEDULE TIPS OFF DEC. 3**

**CLEVELAND** -- The North Coast Conference schedule tips off Saturday with a full slate of league games. Defending champion Kenyon (5-0) tips off its title defense with a home contests against Allegheny (1-3). The Ladies took both regular season games from the Gators last winter. The three other NCAC games set for Saturday are: Oberlin (0-3) at Wittenberg (2-2), Ohio Wesleyan (1-4) at Hiram (0-1) and Wooster (2-2) at Earlham (0-4). Denison opens its conference schedule Wednesday, Dec. 7 at Earlham.

Kenyon was tabbed as the preseason favorite in voting by coaches and media earlier this fall. Wittenberg was second in the coaches' poll, followed by Denison in third; the two teams shared second in media voting. Allegheny was voted fourth, followed by Ohio Wesleyan in fifth in both polls.

**Notes:** **ALLEGHENY** dropped a pair of games last week, falling 70-62 to Washington & Jefferson and dropping 77-71 overtime decision to Mount Union. Senior guard **Caitlin Murtagh (Bethel Park, PA/Seton-LaSalle)** led the team with 17 points against nationally ranked W&J and also pulled down eight rebounds. She and senior forward **Courtney Steding (McDonald, PA/Fort Cherry)** each totalled 18 points against Mt. Union. Murtagh added eight boards and four steals against the Purple Raiders ... **DENISON** advanced to the championship game of the McWilliams Classic hosted by Washington (MO) University with an 82-74 overtime win over Wisconsin-Lutheran. The Big Red suffered an 83-50 loss to the host Bears in the final, which snapped Denison's four-game win streak. In the pair of games in St. Louis, freshman **Carolyn Simpson (Dublin, OH/Scioto)** had 33 points and 17 rebounds, including 19 points and 12 boards against Wisconsin-Lutheran. She is averaging 10.4 points per game and 6.6 rebounds per game in five games. Denison also defeated Thiel, 79-50, earlier last week ... **EARLHAM** dropped a pair of games last week: a 91-50 loss to St. Joseph's and a 71-60 loss to Mt. Saint Joseph. Junior guard **Guin Summerton (Williams, IN/Shoals)** scored a career-high 23 points against St. Joseph's and added 16 against Mt. Saint Joseph. Freshman forward **LeShea Orr (Dayton, OH/Jefferson)** contributed 10 points and 18 rebounds against Mt. Saint Joseph ... **HIRAM** opened its season with a 91-78 loss at Manchester. Junior **Cassie Bedard (Randolph, OH/Waterloo)** paced the Terriers with 24 points ... **KENYON** topped Bethany (WV) at home, 82-58, then travelled to North Park for the Viking Classic. The Ladies improved to 5-0 on the season and claimed the title at the Classic with wins over Carleton, 61-58, and North Park, 56-47. Sophomore guard **Alisha Moreno (Mesa, AZ/Dobson)** was a combined 9-of-12 (.750) from behind the three-point arc. She finished the week with 33 points, five rebounds, seven assists and no turnovers. In the win over North Park, Moreno was a perfect 5-for-5 from three-point land ... **OBERLIN** junior forward **Jessie Oram (New York, NY/Beacon)** racked a career-high 30 points and pulled down 16 rebounds in a 66-62 loss to Bluffton ... **OHIO WESLEYAN** dropped a 64-48 decision to Case before splitting a pair of games at the Marietta Turkey Shootout last week. The Battling Bishops lost their opening game, 76-67, to Notre Dame, but rebounded with an 80-58 win over Chatham in the consolation game. Sophomore guard **Kathleen Cooper (Columbus, OH/Upper Arlington)** tied an OWU record with five three-pointers against Chatham. She finished with a career-high 17 points and added three assists. She also scored 10 points in the opener against Notre Dame and was named to the all-tournament team for her outstanding play ... **WITTENBERG** dropped a pair of road games last week, falling to nationally ranked Baldwin-Wallace, 65-50, and Capital, 60-56. Junior post **Kathy Hittle (Noblesville, IN/Noblesville)** is off to a fast start with three double-doubles in the first three games, followed by a 16-point, nine-rebounds effort in the loss to Capital. Hittle finished the week with 32 points and 20 rebounds in the two games. Junior guard **Gina Carney (Lexington, KY/Catholic)** came off the bench against Capital to establish new career highs in every statistical category. She finished with 11 points on 4-of-5 shooting from the field as Wittenberg rallied from a 14-point first-half deficit to lead by six points midway through the final 20 minutes ... **WOOSTER** won the Ursuline Tournament with wins over Carlow, 62-59, and Muskingum, 55-44. Junior forward **Carly Loehrke (Kalamazoo, MI/Mattawan)** was named MVP of the tournament after pouring in 28 points, 14 in each game, and 14 rebounds, including eight in the title game.

### **NCAC Football Report**

North Coast champion Wabash (11-1) rallied from a 14-0 deficit, but an interception in the Capital endzone ended the Little Giants' season in the second round of the NCAA playoffs. Capital advances in the playoffs with a 14-11 final score. The contest was a battle between the two of the nation's top defenses and it showed as the two teams combined for 10 sacks. Wabash held the Crusaders to just 239 yards of total offense and managed 240 of their own. Senior quarterback **Russ Harbaugh (Evansville, IN/Bosse)**, announced this week as Gagliardi Trophy finalist, completed 21 of 43 passes for 197 yards with one interception. He finished the season with 273 completions and 3,521 yards, both setting Wabash and NCAC records. He shattered his own Wabash single-season completion record with a mark of 69.3 percent, also breaking the NCAC mark of 67.9 set by Allegheny's **Kyle Adamson** in 1995.

### **LOEHRKE, VANDERVAART NAMED NCAC BASKETBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

**CLEVELAND** -- Wooster's **Carly Loehrke (Kalamazoo, MI/Mattawan)** and **Tim Vandervaart (North Canton, OH/Hoover)** have been named women's and men's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

**Loehrke**, a 6-0, junior forward, was named the Ursuline Tournament MVP after she scored 28 points and grabbed 14 rebounds, including eight in the title contest, to lead the Fighting Scots to wins over Carlow and Muskingum. She scored an identical 14 points in each game.

**Vandervaart**, a 6-6, junior forward, earned tournament MVP honors as the Scots won the Emory & Henry Invitational. He scored 16 points and added 16 rebounds in a 77-63 defeat of Methodist, then added 20 points and 17 rebounds in a 150-101 defeat of the hosts in the championship game. Vandervaart shot 12-for-19 (.63.2) from the field, and 12-for-17 (.706) from the line for two-game totals of 36 points and 33 rebounds.
