NCAC Men's Basketball Report

NCAC TEAMS ENTER CONFERENCE PORTION OF SCHEDULE; WOOSTER TOPS STANDINGS AHEAD OF SEVEN TIED FOR SECOND

CLEVELAND -- The North Coast Athletic Conference men's basketball season resumes tomorrow night when Wittenberg (1-1, 8-1) and Ohio Wesleyan (1-1, 7-4) travel to Kenyon (1-1, 5-6) and Denison (0-2, 1-9), respectively. Wooster (3-0, 10-2) stands alone in first through the early part of the conference season and seven other squads are tied for second with 1-1 NCAC marks.

Friday night, Earlham (1-1, 3-8) visits Allegheny (1-1, 5-5) and Wabash (1-1, 4-7) travels to Hiram (1-1, 2-8). Saturday, the Gators and Terriers trade opponents. The Bishops, Tigers and the first-place Scots host the Lords, Oberlin (1-2, 2-8), and the Big Red, respectively on Saturday.

HOOPS NOTES: At the Land of Magic Classic in Orlando, Florida, **ALLEGHENY** lost to 14th-ranked Lawrence, 69-57, and Mary Washington, 68-61. **Larry Sharp (North Wales, PA/Germantown Academy)** tied his career high with 17 points against Lawrence. **Ryan Hollihan (Saxonburg, PA/Knoch)** picked up a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds to lead the Gators against Mary Washington, which had entered the game with an 8-2 record ... Senior **Dan Hodgkinson (Lake Forest, IL/Lake Forest)** led **DENISON** in scoring at the D3 Desert Shootout in Las Vegas. Hodgkinson averaged 23.5 points and shot 60 percent from the field in the two games. He leads the Big Red this season with a 19.2 scoring average. Denison lost to Scranton (70-53) and Clarke (69-52) at the Shootout ... **EARLHAM** is off to a 3-8 start and is 2-3 in the past five. Senior **Markous Jewett (Richmond, IN/Richmond)** averaged 17 points and 5.8 rebounds in that span, including 20 points in a 71-66 defeat of Franklin, 21 in an 84-74 loss to Anderson and 23 in a 61-59 loss to Muskingum ... **HIRAM** junior **Mike McDevitt (Lisbon, OH/David Anderson)** scored a career-high 21 points in a 97-93 double overtime victory over Grove City, and had a double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds in a 63-62 loss to Thiel. Against the TomCats, freshman **Jason Hebeisen (Strongsville, OH/Strongsville)** recorded a career-best 26 points, including 12-for-14 shooting from the free-throw line ... In their only action during the holiday break, **KENYON** nearly upset nationally ranked DePauw, losing on a buzzer-beating three-pointer, 53-52. Sophomore **Korey Haddox (Zanesville, OH/Zanesville)** led the way for the Lords with 14 points and five rebounds ... **OBERLIN** senior **Quinton Spencer (Chicago, IL/Brother Rice)** threw in 22 points and grabbed 12 rebounds in a 76-65 loss to Wilmington on Dec. 13. He added eight points in 24 minutes in a 77-40 loss to Adrian on Dec. 30 ... Despite a flurry of three pointers late in overtime, **OHIO WESLEYAN** dropped an 80-79 decision to Aquinas in the first round of Ashland's Holiday Inn Express Tournament. Junior **post Dustin Rudegeair (Yellow Springs, OH/Yellow Springs)** finished with 22 points to lead the Bishops, then added another 14 in an 86-76 consolation victory over Notre Dame of Ohio. Senior **post Ben Chojnacki (Medina, OH/Medina)** finished with 30 points and 10 boards against the Falcons ... For the third straight year, **WITTENBERG** senior **post Dane Borchers (Russia, OH/Russia)** was named Tournament MVP of the Tigers' Zimmerman Memorial Classic. Borchers totaled 34 points and 16 rebounds as the Tigers defeated York and IU-Southeast to win the tournament. Sophomore wing **Mark Caraway (Jamestown, OH/Greeneview)** and freshman guard **David Nowicki (Carmel, IN/Westfield)** were also named to the all-tournament team ... Junior guard **James Cooper (Springfield, OH/South)** earned all-tournament honors at **WOOSTER'S** 44th annual E.M. "Mose" Hole/Kiwanis Classic. He had a combined 45 points as the Scots lost to Ohio Northern (91-84) and defeated Calvin (98-82). Cooper tallied 18 against the Polar Bears, then put up a game-high 27 on 11-for-17 (.647) shooting to defeat the Knights.

MESSAROS, JEWETT NAMED NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CLEVELAND -- Ohio Wesleyan's **Rachel Messaros (Reynoldsburg, OH/Bishop Hartley)** and Earlham's **Markous Jewett (Richmond, IN/Richmond)** have been named women's and men's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

Messaros, a 5-9, senior wing, led her team to the championship of the Bishop Tournament. Messaros totaled 46 points on 17-for-26 (.654) shooting, and added six rebounds and two assists. In a 76-68 defeat of North Central, she scored 10 points during a 16-3 first-half run that gave OWU the lead for good. She finished with a career-best 26 points. In a 73-59, championship game victory over Ohio Dominican, she led the Bishops with 20 points.

Jewett, an 6-6, senior forward, scored 85 points over five games during the holiday break, including three with 20 or more. In a 71-66 defeat of Franklin, Jewett poured in 20 points and nine rebounds. He followed that with a 21-point, 5-rebound showing in a 10-point loss to Anderson. Jewett's best effort was a 23-point outburst in a two-point loss to Muskingum. He shot 10-for-11 from the free-throw line in that game, and was 28-for-33 (.848) from the charity stripe in the five contests. Jewett also snagged 29 rebounds in that span.

CONFERENCE SCHEDULE RESUMES THIS WEEK;

ALLEGHENY, DENISON, WITTENBERG ENTER WEEK KNOTTED AT FIRST

CLEVELAND -- The 2006-07 North Coast Athletic Conference season resumes this week with a full slate of games. The first NCAC contest after a three week break takes place tonight when Wittenberg (2-0, 5-5) travels to take on Denison (2-0, 8-3) at 7:30 p.m. Tomorrow night, Kenyon (0-2, 3-8) visits Wooster (1-1, 5-5), also starting at 7:30 p.m.

Friday and Saturday, all nine squads play at least once. Friday night, Allegheny (3-0, 9-2) entertains Earlham (1-2, 2-10) and Hiram (0-2, 4-6) welcomes the Tigers. Saturday, the Gators and Terriers trade opponents. Denison (2-0, 8-3) hits the road to face the Ladies Friday night, then heads over to Ohio Wesleyan (1-1, 5-5) on Saturday. The Bishops host Oberlin (0-2, 4-5) Friday night, then the Yeowomen return home to welcome the Scots Saturday afternoon.

HOOPS NOTES: **ALLEGHENY's Jennifer Reimer** tied the school win record with her 110th victory, a 71-62 win over Maryville (Mo.), as head coach of the Gators. Reimer, who is in her seventh season at the helm, tied **Ronda Seagraves** (1986-1992). Entering this week, Reimer has a record of 110-61 with the Gators. Senior **Jennifer Latronica (Gibsonia, PA/Deer Lakes)** was named to the All-Tournament Team at the South Padre Island Shootout. Latronica averaged 10.5 points, 9.5 rebounds and 3.5 blocks per game over two games. Against Maryville, Latronica posted 14 points and 10 rebounds, while sophomore **Stephanie Wolf (Pittsburgh, PA/North Allegheny)** had 12 points and 10 boards ... At the same tournament, the South Padre Island Shootout, **DENISON** claimed the team title after victories over Amherst (60-47) and LeTourneau (78-56). Sophomore **Carolyn Simpson (Dublin, OH/Scioto)** was named the tournament Most Valuable Player after averaging 13 points and eight rebounds over the two games. Senior **Kristen Sheffield (Dublin, OH/Scioto)** was also selected to the all-tournament team. She averaged 12 points per game in the tourney ... **EARLHAM** is off to a 2-10 start. In their most recent victory, a 69-48 decision over St. Mary-of-the-Woods, junior **Whitney McBurrows (Lansing, MI/J.W. Sexton)** led the Quakers with 16 points. She leads Earlham with 16 steals this season, and is second on the team with an 8.3 scoring average ... In five games played over the past three weeks, **HIRAM** senior **Cassie Bedard (Randolph, OH/Waterloo)** has averaged 19.2 points per game, including a career-high 29 points in a loss to Ursuline on Dec. 13. Bedard also pulled down 8.2 caroms per game in that span, and blocked five shots. The Terriers, who have won three of their last four games to improve to 4-6 overall, also got leadership from senior **Tania Carman (University Hts., OH/Cleveland Hts.)**, who recorded 7.4 points and 6.0 rebounds in those contests ... **KENYON** won one of three games at the San Diego Surf-N-Slam Tournament. The Ladies opened the tourney by losing to fifth-ranked DePauw, 68-40, then bounced back to defeat Salve Regina, 44-41. Kenyon wrapped up the tournament with a 63-46 loss to Luther. Junior **Eva George (Lincoln, MA/Lincoln-Sudbury)** scored 26 points and grabbed 17 rebounds in the three games, highlighted by an 11-point, seven-rebound performance in the loss to Luther. Junior **Anne Dugan (Dublin, OH/Watterson)** also contributed 26 points over three games ... **OBERLIN** is off to a 4-5 start and last played Dec. 11, when they fell to Allegheny, 60-44. The Yeomen return to action on Friday night when they head to Ohio Wesleyan ... Speaking of the Bishops, **OHIO WESLEYAN** evened its record at 5-5 with victories over North Central (76-68) and Ohio Dominican (73-59) to win their own Bishop Classic last week. Senior wing **Rachel Messaros (Reynoldsburg, OH/Bishop Hartley)** scored a career-high 27 points in the victory over North Central, including 10 in a 16-3 first-half run that gave OWU the lead for good. Junior wing **Steffi Graf (Poland, OH/Seminary)** finished with 26 points in the two games, while junior post **Kelli Lester (Pataskala, OH/Watkins Memorial)** grabbed a career-best 12 boards against North Central and another 11 in the victory over ODU. Lester had a double-double in both games, scoring 11 and 14 points. Graf and Messaros were selected to the all-tournament team ... **WITTENBERG** posted a 1-2 record against top-25 teams in the past few weeks. On Dec. 20, the Tigers defeated nationally ranked Wilmington, 77-68, as senior wing **Rachel Clark-Haggy (South Charleston, OH/Southeastern)** poured in 17 points. Clark-Haggy and senior post **Kathy Hittle (Noblesville, IN/Noblesville)** were named to the all-tournament team in Wittenberg's Zimmerman Memorial Classic as the Tigers finished second ... **WOOSTER** defeated LaVerne (62-57) and lost to Whittier (56-57) in a pair of games in California. The Scots came back east and took a trip to Michigan. Wooster lost to Olivet (75-43) before defeating Kalamazoo (75-63). Freshman guard **Kym Wenz (Avon Lake, OH/Avon Lake)** is the squad's leading scorer at 14.1 points per game after she combined for 29 points in the two contests in Michigan. Wenz recorded a career best 22 points in the win over Kalamazoo, and added nine boards, three assist and five steals in the contest.
