NCAC Men's Basketball Report

**WITTENBERG AND WOOSTER REMAIN UNDEFEATED IN CONFERENCE PLAY;
TIGERS, SCOTS TO MEET ON SATURDAY IN SPRINGFIELD**

CLEVELAND -- Wittenberg (4-0, 11-2) and Wooster (4-0, 8-5) remained on top of the North Coast Athletic Conference men's basketball standings, each posting one victory in NCAC action to improve to 4-0 in league play. Both squads hit the road Wednesday with the Tigers visiting ninth-place (tie) Earlham (0-4, 2-11) and the Scots traveling to eighth-place Hiram (1-3, 4-9). Saturday night, the two teams square off in Springfield at 7:30 p.m. Every North Coast team is scheduled for two conference contests in the coming week.

Ohio Wesleyan (3-1, 8-4), which enters the week alone in third place, hits the road to face fourth-place (tie) Wabash (2-2, 8-5) Wednesday. The Bishops then return home to welcome the Quakers on Saturday. Two teams tied for fourth with the Little Giants -- Allegheny (2-2, 7-6) and Kenyon (2-2, 4-9) -- play road games Wednesday, with the Gators traveling to the fourth team involved in the fourth-place tie, Oberlin (2-2, 3-10) and the Lords heading to ninth-place (tie) Denison (0-4, 0-13). Rounding out the schedule are Saturday tilts featuring Wabash at Oberlin, Hiram at Denison, and Kenyon at Allegheny.

NOTES: **ALLEGHENY** dropped a pair of games, one in conference play. In a 64-48 loss to Penn State-Behrend, **Charlie Jaicks (Gibsonia, PA/Mars)** led the Gators with 16 points. Three key players did not play in the game due to injury. A 72-55 loss to Wittenberg came despite a career-high 19 points from **Craig Devinney (Allison Park, PA/Shaler Area)** and a 16-point, 17-rebound effort from **George Raftis (Pittsburgh, PA/Sewickley Academy)** ... In its only action last week, **DENISON** dropped a 75-70 decision to Oberlin despite five players reaching double figures in scoring. Junior guard **Pat Sullivan (Loveland, OH/Loveland)** led the way with 17 points and five assists ... Junior **Tristian Gregory (Evansville, IN/Harrison)** led **EARLHAM** in a 71-51 loss to Kenyon. Gregory scored a team-best 17 points and added three assists ... **HIRAM** defeated non-conference Geneva by a 113-95 score, then lost to NCAC foe Ohio Wesleyan, 91-53. **Mike McDevitt (Lisbon, OH/David Anderson)** scored 31 points and grabbed 18 rebounds in the two contests ... **KENYON** split a pair of conference games last week, falling to Ohio Wesleyan, 76-63, before defeating Earlham, 71-51. Sophomore **Dave Knapke (Westerville, OH/St. Francis DeSales)** scored a combined 30 points and grabbed 14 rebounds, and shot 56 percent from the field. In the victory over the Quakers, Knapke registered his sixth double-double of the year with 14 points and 10 boards ... Senior guard **Jordan Beard (Oberlin, OH/Oberlin)** led **OBERLIN** to its first home victory of the season when the Yeomen upended Denison, 75-70. Beard scored a team-high 19 points on 6 of 12 shooting, including three three-pointers. Against Yale, to which Oberlin fell, 92-41, Beard had a team-best 15 points. For the week, he averaged 17 points per game on 45.8 percent shooting, was 6 of 13 from three point range (46.2 percent) and hit all six of his free-throw attempts ... **OHIO WESLEYAN** rolled off a pair of NCAC victories to improve to 3-1 in conference play. Senior post **Dustin Rudegear (Yellow Springs, OH/Yellow Springs)** led the Battling Bishops with 21 points on 9 for 12 shooting and shared the team lead with nine rebounds in a 76-63 defeat of Kenyon, then finished with team bests in points (23) and rebounds (11) in a 91-53 victory over Hiram ... **WABASH** dropped its only contest of the week, 72-70 to Wooster. Senior **Andrew Zimmer (Hobart, IN/Hobart)** led the way with 21 points, seven rebounds and four blocked shots. Senior **Gary Simkus (Highland, IN/Highland)** hit 18 points on 6 of 10 shooting including 5 for 5 from long range ... **WITTENBERG** defeated Allegheny, 72-55, for its only action of the week. **Gregg Hill (Farmington Hills, MI/Redford Union)** scored 29 points ... Freshman post **Bryan Wickliffe (Columbus, OH/St. Charles Prep)** scored a season-best 20 points, including a put-back on an offensive rebound with 17 seconds left to lift **WOOSTER** over Wabash, 72-70. Wickliffe also shared the team leading with six rebounds.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK (Jan. 13)

Denison's **Ellen O'Brien (Bethesda, MD/Walt Whitman)** and Ohio Wesleyan's **Dustin Rudegear (Yellow Springs, OH/Yellow Springs)** have been named women's and men's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

O'Brien, a 5-5, junior point guard, averaged 12.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, four assists and two steals in the Big Red's 2-0 week. Denison defeated Ohio Wesleyan and Hiram, wresting third place from the Bishops' grasp

Rudegear, a 6-5, senior post, led the Bishops as Ohio Wesleyan rolled off a pair of NCAC victories to improved to 3-1 in conference play. Rudegear posted a team-high 21 points on 9 for 12 shooting and shared the team lead with nine rebounds in a 76-63 defeat of Kenyon, then finished with team bests in points (23) and rebounds (11) in a 91-53 victory over Hiram.

NCAC Women's Basketball Report

KENYON AND WITTENBERG REMAIN UNDEFEATED AND TIED; LADIES AND TIGERS TO MEET IN SPRINGFIELD ON WEDNESDAY

CLEVELAND -- Kenyon (5-0, 8-6) and Wittenberg (5-0, 6-5) continue to share the league lead atop the North Coast Athletic Conference women's basketball standings, each with perfect 5-0 conference marks. The two teams square off for the first time this season on Wednesday on Wittenberg's home floor. Tip-off is set for 7:30 p.m.

The Ladies head to fifth-place Allegheny (2-3, 5-9) Saturday, while the Tigers take a break from NCAC play with a home contest against Thomas More that afternoon.

Third-place Denison (3-1, 7-6), which moved up from fourth to third after a pair of North Coast wins last week, looks to keep things rolling with a road game at sixth-place Wooster (1-3, 4-8) Wednesday and a home contest on Saturday against ninth-place Oberlin (0-4, 1-11).

The Gators begin the week with a home contest against the Yeowomen Wednesday before facing Kenyon on the weekend. Ohio Wesleyan (4-2, 9-5), which slipped to fourth after a 1-1 week, travels to eighth-place Earlham (1-5, 2-12) for both squad's only action in the coming week.

Rounding out the schedule, the Scots visit seventh-place Hiram (1-4, 3-10).

Notes: In their only action last week, **ALLEGHENY** lost to Ohio Wesleyan, 77-52. **Emilie Simone (Pittsburgh, PA/Mt. Lebanon)** and **Jill Gregory (Jeanette, PA/Greensburg Central Catholic)** led the Gators by scoring 11 points each ... Freshman **Shaina Kaiser (Ostrander, OH/Buckeye Valley)** hit 9 of 12 shots in two victories as **DENISON** went 2-0 in North Coast action. She averaged 11.5 points per game including a career-high 14 in a 77-53 defeat of Hiram. Junior point guard **Ellen O'Brien (Bethesda, MD/Walt Whitman)** averaged 12.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, four assists and two steals. The Big Red also knocked off Ohio Wesleyan, 68-63, wresting third place in the North Coast from the Bishops' grasp ... **EARLHAM** sophomore **Shontavia Davis (Indianapolis, IN/Warren Central)** scored 16 points and grabbed nine rebounds to lead the Quakers in a 78-62 loss to Wittenberg. Davis added another 14 in a 71-46 loss to Kenyon ... **HIRAM** played once last week and lost to Denison, 77-53. Sophomore **Pamela Spencer (Massillon, OH/Washington)** scored 10 points to lead the Terriers ... The Ladies of **KENYON** extended their win streak to five with North Coast wins over Wooster (62-49) and Earlham (71-46). Senior forward **Anne Dugan (Dublin, OH/Watterson)** averaged 18.5 points and 5.5 rebounds in the two games, shooting 5 of 8 in three-point attempts and 8 of 8 from the line ... Senior **Roneisha Kinney (Cleveland, OH/Rhodes)** recorded a double-double with 12 points and 10 boards in **OBERLIN'S** 69-53 loss to Kalamazoo. Kinney also paced the Yeowomen in a 66-48 loss to Wittenberg with game-highs in points (17), rebounds (9) and blocks (3) ... In a 68-63 loss to Denison, **OHIO WESLEYAN** freshman post **Kayla Gordon (St. Louis, MO/Mehlville)** posted a team-high 19 points, then contributed 11 more in a 77-52 defeat of Allegheny. Senior wing **Steffi Graf (Poland, OH/Seminary)** paced the Battling Bishops with 24 points in the victory and totaled 34 points in two games ... **WITTENBERG** defeated Earlham, 78-62 as **Stephanie Boardman (Cincinnati, OH/McAuley)** contributed a career-high 24 points. The Tigers then extended their win streak to four with a 66-48 defeat of Oberlin. **Victoria Leali (Jackson, OH/Jackson)** led the way with 13 points on 5 of 10 shooting, three assists, three steals and two blocks. Wittenberg poured in nine three pointers in 22 attempts against the Yeowomen ... **WOOSTER** played once last week and dropped a 62-49 decision to Kenyon. Sophomore post **Kaitlin Krister (Kent, OH/Walsh Jesuit)** led the squad with 15 points, eight rebounds and two blocked shots.

NCAC Swimming & Diving Report NCAC TEAMS RETURN TO ACTION

All eight schools return to the pool for the resumption of the North Coast swimming campaign. Teams have one month left to prepare for the North Coast Athletic Conference Swimming & Diving Championships. The 24th annual NCAC meet will be held at Branin Natatorium in Canton, Ohio, from Feb. 13-16.

Men's notes: **ALLEGHENY** defeated Hiram, 122-101, as **Ryan Lawrence (Union City, PA/Union City)** won the 200 freestyle with his season-best time of 1:49.29. He was also part of the winning 400-yard medley and 400 freestyle relays. **Colin Gundling (Murrysville, PA/Franklin Regional)** and **Josh Sesek (Pittsburgh, PA/Brentwood)** won the 50-yard freestyle (23.32) and 200-yard breaststroke (2:16.34), respectively and were part of the victorious 400 medley relay ... The top-ranked **DENISON** team defeated Wittenberg, 145-75, on the strength of 10 first-place finishes. Junior **David Curtis (Ann Arbor, MI/Pioneer)** touched first in the 500 freestyle and 50 freestyle. Junior **John Geissinger (Darien, CT/The Lawrenceville School)** took first in the 200 free (1:47.83) and was part of the winning 200 medley relay ... **HIRAM** dropped a 144-83 decision to Wooster and a 122-101 loss to Allegheny last week. Freshmen **Zach Wegman (Knoxville, TN/Bereon)** and **Santiago Morales (Mexico City, Mexico/Colegio Bilbao)** led the Terriers. Wegman won the 800 meter freestyle (9:32.24) and the 100-meter butterfly (1:01.97) against the Scots. Against the Gators, he took first in the 1000-yard freestyle (10:24.59), 200-yard butterfly (2:08.55) and 500-yard freestyle (5:03.54). Morales won three events during the week, touching first in the 200-meter individual medley against Wooster (2:13.82) and the 400-yard IM (4:28.82) and 200-yard backstroke (2:08.38) at Allegheny ... **OBERLIN** lost to Ohio Northern, 189-92, but still got a victory from **Jon Vimr (Savoy, IL/Champaign Central)** in the 200-yard freestyle with a time of 1:51.30. **Daniel Holm (Monroeville, PA/Gateway Senior)** was victorious in the 100 back (1:06.16), while freshman **Corey Spiro (Solon, OH/Solon)** won the 100 butterfly (54.70). **Scott McInerney (Randolph, NJ/Randolph)** sang the national anthem prior to the meet with former Oberlin swimmer **Melissa Ising** ... Sophomore **Kevin Fahey (Delaware, OH/Hayes)** won the 500 and 1000 freestyles with times of 5:08.86 and 10:38.47, respectively, to lead **OHIO WESLEYAN** in its defeat at the hands of Wooster, 147-67. Sophomore **David Gatz (Delaware, OH/Hayes)** touched first in the 200 breast in 2:09.90 ... **WABASH** lost to Washington (Mo.), 172-126, despite an outstanding performance by sophomore **Elijah Sanders (Mt. Vernon, IN/Mt. Vernon)**. Sanders set a school and pool record with his victory in the 1000 free, finishing in 9:51.07 to break a record that was set in 2000. Sophomore **Adam Petro (Indianapolis, IN/Decatur Central)** won the 200 back (1:58.87). Diver **Core Hatcher (Crawfordsville, IN/Southmont)** won the one-meter board with 211.70 points, and the three-meter competition with 209.55 points ... **WITTENBERG** swimming defeated Transylvania, 139-100, as **Neil Anderson (Lakewood, OH/Lakewood)** won the 500 free and 200 free. The Tigers also lost to Denison, 145-75 last week ... The Scots of **WOOSTER** won a pair of meets against NCAC foes, defeating Hiram, 144-83, and knocking off Ohio Wesleyan, 147-67. Sophomore **Eric Babbitt (Rancho Santa Margarita, CA/Santa Margarita Catholic)** won three events in the week. Babbitt took first in the 50 free (25.24) at Hiram, then took the 200 free (1:50.45) and 200 fly (2:06.61) against the Bishops. The 200 free relay set a Hiram pool record with a 1:38.21 clocking.

Women's Notes: **ALLEGHENY** defeated Hiram, 126-102 as **Ashley Whitehead (Meadville, PA/Meadville Area)** won the 50 free (25:18) and 100 free (56.48) and was part of the winning 400 medley relay. **Glenna Kramer (Oakdale, PA/West Allegheny)** won both diving events ... **DENISON** lost to Ohio U., 136-105, then defeated Wittenberg, 133-83. Freshman **Ksenia Golovkina (Newton, MA/Newton South)** made an NCAA automatic qualifying time in the 100 breaststroke when she touched in 1:05.11 against the Bobcats. **Olivia Zaleski (Corry, PA/Corry Area)** won the 100 fly (59.19) and **Kristen Hohl (Winfield, IL/Wheaton North)** took first in the 100 free (53.27). Against the Tigers, the Big Red won eight events ... **HIRAM** lost to Wooster, 161-73 and to Allegheny, 126-102. Senior **Shelly Leshe (Palm City, FL/Martin County)** was a bright spot as she won the 200-meter free (2:14.01) and 100-meter fly (1:07.01) against the Scots, then taking the 200-yard fly (2:14.18) against the Gators ... **OBERLIN** lost a tight meet to Ohio Northern, 150-148. Freshman **Sara Kadi (Piedmont, CA/Piedmont)** won the 200 fly (2:15.70), 100 fly (1:00.21) and 200 IM (2:15.52) to lead the Yeowomen against the Polar Bears. The next day, Oberlin rebounded to defeat Notre Dame (OH), 176-111. Kadi won the 50 breast (33.76), 100 back (1:03.24) and 500 free (5:23.02), and was the anchor on the winning 400 free relay ... In a 146-79 loss to Wooster, **OHIO WESLEYAN** freshman **Brenna Irrer (Ann Arbor, MI/Pioneer)** won the 200 breast (2:39.77). Sophomore diver **Erin Hanahan (Madison, OH/Perry)** took the three-meter event with 168.05 points ... **Kaitlin Clark (Shubertown, OH/Firelands)** led **WITTENBERG** past Transylvania, 165-73, as she won the 1000 free, 400 IM and 500 free. **Megan Shakutowski (Columbus, OH/Watterson)** took both diving events. In a 133-83 loss to Denison, **Adeline Brym (Mansfield, OH/Lexington)** won the 200 free and 500 free ... **WOOSTER** swept Hiram, 161-73, and Ohio Wesleyan, 146-79. Sophomore **Amanda Bailey (Westlake, OH/Westlake)** won every individual event she entered in the two meets. Bailey won the 400 free (4:50.23), 800 free (10:01.55) at Hiram, then took the 500 free (5:37.60) and 1000 free (11:23.78) at home against the Bishops.
