### Golfer of the Week

#### Golfer of the Week: Luke Moton, Wabash

Event: St. Francis 36-hole Invitational  
Course: Cobblestone Golf Course, Kendallville, Indiana  
Individual Score: 78+72=150  
Team Finish: 6th of 9  
Team Score: 314+305=619

Wabash junior **Luke Moton (Batesville, IN/Batesville)** put together his best 36-hole score of the season by shooting a 150 at the St. Francis Invitational. He led the Little Giants to a sixth-place team finish. Moton's rounds of 78 and 72 put him in a tie for ninth in the individual standings.

### Notes

The 26th North Coast Athletic Conference Golf Championship will be decided on Saturday and Sunday at the Mount Vernon Country Club. Kenyon serves as host of the NCAC Invitational, which is the fourth event of the 2009-10 Golf Championship Series. After three events, Wittenberg holds the overall lead with a total team score of 1787 strokes. Defending champion Ohio Wesleyan stands second with 1826, while Allegheny is third at 1855.

The Battling Bishops have won 14 NCAC golf titles, including eight of the past 10 and the last three in a row. The only other team to win a North Coast golf championship over that span is Allegheny, which won in 2001 and 2006. In all, the Gators have won nine titles. Wooster won the very first North Coast title contested in 1985, and Wittenberg won its only championship in 1992.

**DENISON** finished 11th of 16 teams at the Nye Intercollegiate hosted by Wooster. Freshman **Connor Monaghan (Garden City, NY/The Peddie School)** shot two rounds of 79 (158) for a 20th-place tie. Freshman **Steven Geldart (Lexington, MA/Lexington)** fired a team-best 78 on day two.

**KENYON** placed 12th at the Nye Intercollegiate. Junior **Jesse Boomsma-Gold (Pelham, MA/Amherst Regional)** led the team with a two-day total of 165, including a 79 in the second round.

**HIRAM** took 13th at the Nye Intercollegiate. Junior **Andy Deehr (Cortland, OH/Champion)** led Hiram with a two-day total 164 and placed in a tie for 40th. Sophomore **Bob Ritchie (Strongsville, OH/Brunswick)** shot a pair of 85's to finish second on the team with 170 strokes.

**OBERLIN** did not place at the Nye Intercollegiate as two players withdrew on the final day. Sophomore **Jake Panka (Prairie Du Chien, WI/ Prairie Du Chien)** finished with a two-day total of 182.

**OHIO WESLEYAN** finished seventh of seven teams at Fossum Invitational, hosted by Michigan State University. Freshman **Mark Fischer (Garden City, NY/Garden City)** finished in 14th place among individuals with a 223. Senior **Jesse Chiero (Westerville, OH/South)** and senior **Tommy Harman (Perrysburg, OH/Perrysburg)** tied for 26th place at 231.

**WABASH** took sixth of nine teams at University of St. Francis Invitational. Junior golfer **Luke Moton (Batesville, IN/Batesville)** put together his best 36-hole score of the season by shooting a 150. He opened with a 78 in the early session, then went back out and fired an even-par 72 to finish in a tie for ninth place at the single-day event.

**WOOSTER** took 9th place at the Nye Intercollegiate. Senior **Tim Sullivan (Bethel Park, PA/Seton-LaSalle)** finished in 16th place with a two-day total of 156. Sophomore **Michael Peters (Evanston, IL/ Evanston Township)** was one stroke behind with a 157, good for a tie for 17th.
