## 2009 NCAA Championships

### Football

North Coast Athletic Conference champion Wittenberg (12-0) defeated Trine, 34-17, in the second round of the NCAA tournament. It was Tigers' 19th victory in NCAA Division III tournament play, and gives them their first appearance in the national quarterfinals since 2001. Wittenberg dominated time of possession, 38:48 to 21:12, to wear down the visiting Thunder. Trine managed just 250 yards of offense against the Tigers' top-ranked defense.

Senior quarterback **Aaron Huffman (Newark, OH/Newark)** led the Wittenberg offense with 208 passing yards and a school-record-tying five touchdowns. The five TDs lifted Huffman to 28 on the season, giving him the single-season school mark in that category. Junior tailback **Corey Weber (Pataskala, OH/Watkins Memorial)** topped 200 yards rushing (204) for the first time in his career to lead the Tigers to 260 yards accumulated on the ground.

In the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Tournament, Wittenberg travels to take on Wisconsin-Whitewater (12-0), which humbled Illinois Wesleyan, 45-7, at Perkins Stadium last week. The Warhawks are ranked second in the nation and were the national runner up last year. The champions of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference have a current streak of four consecutive appearances in the NCAA Division III championship game. It will be the first meeting between the schools. Kickoff is set for 12 noon, central time.
