**ALL-NCAC WOMEN'S LACROSSE SQUAD ANNOUNCED;
DENISON'S FROST, BUHR EARN TOP INDIVIDUAL HONORS**

CLEVELAND - Denison senior midfielder **Krissy Frost (Wilton, CT/Wilton)** and senior defender **Lindsay Buhr (Manhasset, NY/Manhasset)** have been named Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year to highlight the 2007 All-North Coast Athletic Conference women's lacrosse selections.

Frost finished the regular season and NCAC Tournament with 49 goals and eight assists for an average of 4.07 points per game, good for fourth in the NCAC scoring race. She makes her fourth appearance on the all-conference team and second on the first team. Frost was the NCAC's Newcomer of the Year in 2004.

Buhr was the defensive cornerstone for Denison. She led the conference in ground balls (3.67 per game) and was fourth in caused turnovers (1.67 pg). She moves up to the first team after earning second-team recognition in 2006.

Four repeat first-teamers join Frost and Buhr. Denison junior **Quinn Simmons (Medina, OH/Medina)** and Allegheny junior **Ashley Hughes (Wexford, PA/North Allegheny)** make their second straight appearances on the first team, earning their third All-NCAC nods overall. Oberlin sophomore midfielder **Lela Hull (Cumberland, ME/Greely)** and Wooster sophomore defender **Romy Eberle (New Haven, CT/Hopkins)** are also repeat first-team selections. Kenyon junior attacker **Amanda Drummond (Mayfield Hts., OH/Hawken)**, Ohio Wesleyan junior midfielder **Julia Fouts (Cleveland Hts., OH/Hathaway Brown)** and goalkeeper **Maggie Eichenlaub (Crystal, MN/Robbinsdale Cooper)** all move up to the first team after being voted to the second team last season.

Kenyon attacker **Frankie De Lavis (Wilton, CT/Hopkins)** was voted Newcomer of the Year. The freshman led the conference in scoring with a school-record 60 goals (4.29 gpg) and 34 assists (2.43 apg) for 94 points and a 6.71 scoring average. De Lavis also finished third in the North Coast with 3.36 draw controls per game.

Wooster's **Liz Ford** and Kenyon's **Jill Boffa** share Coach of the Year honors. Both earn the award for the first time in their careers. Ford led the Fighting Scots to their fourth NCAC title, the first under her leadership, and a 12-5 record. She is 23-7 in two years as Wooster's head coach. Boffa, the first Kenyon skipper to win this award since 1986, guided the Ladies to a 7-7 record, a four-game improvement over 2006. She is 10-16 in two years as the mentor of the Kenyon program.
