ALL-NCAC WOMEN'S SOCCER SQUAD ANNOUNCED;
LUSTIC, COCHRAN CLAIM INDIVIDUAL HONORS

CLEVELAND -- Wooster senior forward **Erin Lustic (Cleveland Hts., OH/Cleveland Hts.)** and Denison junior defender **Kim Cochran (Upper Arlington, OH/Upper Arlington)** have been named Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year to highlight the 2006 All-North Coast Athletic Conference women's soccer selections.

Lustic, who earns her third straight first-team nod, scored 10 goals and added seven assists for the third-place (tie) Fighting Scots. Wooster advanced to the NCAC tournament for the third time. The offensive-minded Scots led the conference in assists (35) and assists per game (1.84), and were second in goals (56) and goals per game (2.32), as well as in points (123) and points per game (6.47).

Cochran also earns her third straight first-team recognition after leading the Big Red to a third-place (tie) in the conference, and the title game of the NCAC tournament, which they entered as the third seed. Denison had the top-rated defense in the conference, with the fewest goals allowed (10) and lowest goals-against average (0.47) in the league. The Big Red have advanced to the sectionals of the NCAA tournament, and face Calvin on Friday at the University of Rochester in Rochester, NY. Game time is set for 1:30 p.m.

Four other players are repeat first-teamers. Denison senior **Anne Young (Columbus, OH/Worthington Kilbourne)** earns her fourth first-team All-NCAC honor, while Wittenberg senior **Jamie McIntyre (Columbus, OH/Grandview)** makes her third appearance in a row on the first team and fourth overall. McIntyre was a second-team choice as a freshman in 2003. Wooster junior **Laura Ayer (Pittsburgh, PA/Mt. Lebanon)** and Ohio Wesleyan sophomore **Michelle Corbett (Dublin, OH/Scioto)** are the other repeat first-team selections. Ayer also earned an honorable mention nod two seasons ago, while the honor is Corbett's first.

Four players move up after earning second-team recognition in 2005. Denison senior **Tammy Hoch (Moon Twp., PA/Sewickley Academy)**, Kenyon juniors **Amanda Drummond (Mayfield Hts., OH/Hawken)** and **Jean Arnold (Atlanta, GA/Westminster)**, and Wittenberg sophomore **Suzanne Medwid (Columbus, OH/Upper Arlington)** each make their first appearance on the First Team.

Wooster forward **Winnie Adrien (Selden, NY/Blair Academy, NJ)** was named 2006 Newcomer of the Year after scoring 15 goals and adding eight assists to lead the conference with 2.00 points per game. She was the only freshman to be selected First Team All-NCAC this season.

Kenyon head coach **Kelly Walters** was voted Coach of the Year for the first time. She guided the Ladies to their first NCAC championship and their first-ever berth in the NCAA Division III tournament. In four years as the mentor of the Kenyon program, Walters is 41-30-3, and is 97-54-10 in eight seasons as a collegiate head coach.
